

Case #200

① Stephen Michalak case, Falcon Lake, Manitoba, May 20, 1967

- Results of soil analysis - a radiation value of .3 microcuries (Dr. A.H. Smith of Nat Health & Welfare Ottawa) radiation sand by lab. to be from a radium source and is a possible serious health hazard.
 - Apparent effect on the surrounding foliage - broken report (13-9-67) stated .5 uCi of Ra-226 (pure radium) on its equivalent.
 - Results, if any, of radar contact - none, but "radioactive contamination of rock & chicken was found at the alleged UFO landing site. The origin of this contamination has yet to be determined." (Report of Mrs. S.E. Hunt of Radiation Protection Division, N.H. & W. Dept)
 - etc. - no mention of such.
 - Has any follow-up been made by a government agency to determine the extent of his illness - nothing on file
 - Does the government have any intention of offering assistance to him since he has been unable to secure complete medical attention in Winnipeg? - no mention
- Apart from a couple of newspaper clippings on this sighting, the last item in the file is a letter from TC of Winnipeg, enclosing a recent medical report on Michalak, but the medical report itself is not in the file. Letter dated 25 Sep. 67. The lengthy RCMP report is missing from the file.

② Charlewood, Manitoba sighting, October 1967 (Mr. E. Forney)
