Dear Allen:

Thank you for your letter of October 16, 1978 in which you granted permission to copy from The Edge of Reality.

You wanted to know the results of this course which I gave at Algonquin College. In my view, it was quite successful. The critiques from the students certainly indicate that they thought so too. The College must have been satisfied as they have asked me to repeat it, which I will do commencing January 13th.

The course was 30 hours, 3 hours a night, one night a week for ten weeks. A copy of the Course Outline is attached. The course was limited to 30 students. Three or four dropped out for unknown reasons.

I made use of the three slide/cassette sets which you put together and which are available from Edmund Scientific Co. These are excellent and the class found them very interesting. I hope you may find time to put together one or two more of these excellent audio/visual presentations.

An interesting aspect of this course was the publicity generated by press, radio and TV. It even made the front page of an Ottawa newspaper.

I will make a few minor changes in the next course based on my first experience, but nothing major. I use Dr. Allen McNamara as a guest lecturer to present the viewpoint of "official science". This adds great interest and much discussion.
