Dear friend:

At Admiral Fahrney's request, we are enclosing information about plans for the National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena — NICAP.

We appreciate very much your desire to join or start a flying saucer club in your community. We have had similar requests from many parts of the country and we are now completing plans for NICAP affiliated flying saucer clubs with NICAP membership. When this information is available, we shall be glad to forward it to you.

Meantime, you might mention NICAP's plans to your friends who are interested. Perhaps you can help secure enough NICAP members to form the nucleus of a NICAP affiliated club in your area.

May I suggest that your first aim should be the enlisting of persons seriously interested in FACTS, in the careful weighing of evidence; also, if it is possible for you to secure as members such technically trained persons as pilots, professional or amateur astronomers, radarmen and engineers, you will find this a great help in examining UFO reports before forwarding them to our headquarters.

Within a short time NICAP will publish a UFO reporting form which will serve as a guide in the collection and evaluation of flying saucer reports. Copies will be sent to all NICAP affiliated clubs, as well as to persons who wish to report sightings.

The names of all NICAP affiliated clubs will be listed in our monthly newsletter, which will also make public the most recent sightings and all important developments in the flying saucer field.

Thank you for your interest in NICAP's aims and work. I hope we can soon list you and your friends among our members.
