Dear Grant:

Thanks for the letter and ATI form and clipping of July 2. I'll try to answer your questions first

1. In response to my latest request for documents mentioned in DRB 3800-10-1 I have been told on the phone by Dupuis of DND that all the files I requested had been destroyed. I expect a formal letter to that effect fairly soon perhaps with copies of the destruction papers.. supposedly back in the 1960's which seems a bit strange since there is still plenty of even older material around the archives. I did get a copy of 3800-10-1 finally. There are some mentions of Smith and he does come up quite often in the voluminous Second Storey files . I had the idea that Chris has a set of the files.. does he? 3800-10-1 has over 300 pages legal size... 2nd Storey is at least as large....

3. There are few good researchers in the US... some make lots of requests but don't understand how the system works. In Washington there are the National Archives, Modern Military Branch.. and the manuscript library of the Library of Congress. MMB is cluttered and the people don't seem to know where much of anything is. If you don't have a specific request for a specific document it can be very hard to find anything. I know of no one in the US who has really dug into the Smith stuff anymore than Bill Moore and I have. Dr. Fred Beckman has worked with Hynek for more than 15 years, is expert at certain aspects of photographic analysis, plays things very close to the vest... very sharp. doesn't communicate very much.

4. I can add nothing to the clipping though my impression is that the writer overdid it considerably... but I have no details. You may get something as a part response to your request

5. Todd Zechel last I hear was either back in Wisconsin where his parents are or back down in Los Angeles. He hasn't so far as I know been staying in NY for several years. I wouldn't trust him as far as I can throw an elephant.. he is a deadbeat, has often lied , misrepresented and jumped to conclusions... Truth is not his primary concern. Steve Stoikes may well be a pseudonym for Todd.. don't know him

6. There is no way to file ^{/ in the US or Canada either} for documents under subject titles such as geomagnetics, anti gravity, UFOs etc. One has to go to specific departments with specific requests. The department will not compile information that doesn't exist yet... such as lists of letters or papers. The department often takes months to reply.. One can do library searches of technical literature with on line search systems such as Dialog which probably have thousands of documents about any technical subject.. Chris knows about such searches...

7. I would be delighted to review DOT stuff when I get to Ottawa.. date uncertain.. I am seeking lots more stuff myself on the basis of more careful review of 3800-10-1.. may all be gone by now.. will let you know.....

Regards to Chris.. Tell him I am also working on tracking down some of the people mentioned in various documents.. doubt if many will talk but.....

Dear Scott:

Grant wrote and I responded. I appreciate your kind words...and will try to help by answering your questions...

1. I saw a note to Lee Graham saying Gordon Gray's papers were at Carlisle. So far the best I can come up with is the Army War College at Carlisle Barracks in Carlisle. I presume they have some Archives or a library etc. The general rules for military or government archives where there is classified material seem to me to be pretty much the same. There are no open stacks. You must ask for what you want after reviewing what may be a thorough or very incomplete Finders Guide. This can range from "Top Secret Correspondence, (1948-1951) 5 feet" to an actual listing of file folder titles. Often some material is still classified and cannot be examined. One lists the Archive boxes, usually 6" thick, and the archivist will bring a cart full. There are rules about taking out one folder at a time from one box at a time and sometimes one must mark with paper folders those items of which one wants copies. Some times one has copy machines present (Library of Congress, Manuscript Division) Usually one does not (Ike, Truman, etc) Copy costs range from a dime in the LC machines to 0.35 per page when they make them... I would suggest calling them, asking for a finders guide re Gray or at least how much material they have from what time frame and whether there are restrictions on access. I had to get Curt Lemay's permission to see his material and a clearance for SECRET items.. turns out there was a list of several hundred TOP SECRET materials I could not see. Usually there is a procedure for requesting classification review, but the titles are cryptic indeed.

2. I sure would like to know who told you that ^Aquarius materials were received in the mail with MJ-12 items. This is totally false. AQ stuff was received in person or by mail but certainly with no connection whatsoever to the MJ-12 roll of 35mm film. I have NOT yet claimed the MJ_12 stuff is factual, but that none of the arguments made against them stand up and there is a great deal of independent verification of the contents. About Aquarius.. who can say? There was such a project (Verified by Bruce Maccabee).

3. Stan sent me some material.. haven't read most of it yet. He mentioned your visit.

4. No, I don't have a file on Stealth and UFOs... have heard ^{UFO sighting} reports suggesting the presence of a plasma around the saucers which can be tuned to be totally absorbent to certain frequency radar signals... Judging by the article in the current Popular Science that is NOT the technique used in Stealth... I met Sweetman author of the book about Stealth.. I don't think he talks about plasmas either.. quite sophisticated...

5. I have heard rumors about the Nellis ATC, but no info. What is the UAPA Symposium?

6. If I can locate the FAIE Item I will send.. also enclosing "Debunking a Debunker".. The version in the MUFON CONF. Proceedings was derived from mine by Bill Moore...

Researcher Stanton Friedman, over a period of several years, managed to track down some of the people Smith contacted in 1950 and ultimately he located Dr. Robert Sarbacher, an American scientist. It appears that Sarbacher was the source of Smith's information. Sarbacher did not, of course, explicitly remember Smith, but he did remember being contacted by another scientist in the Canadian Embassy. Included with EXHIBIT C is Sarbacher's response to explicit questions by researcher William Steinman. The letter quite clearly indicates his knowledge of a secret project. Furthermore, he recalled a brief description of the occupants of the "craft." Also included with this EXHIBIT is a copy of notes I made while talking to Sarbacher in 1985. He died in the summer of 1986.

EXHIBIT D

On Dec. 8, 1950 the Army Counter Intelligence Corps confidentially advised the Richmond, VA FBI office that the Corps had been put on IMMEDIATE HIGH ALERT for any information concerning flying saucers.

I explained to him that I was interested in UFOs from the scientific and historical standpoint. I couldn't locate records because of changes in recording systems. I explained the problems of archival research. He got the point that we need a place to start....project name, code number, person, etc.

He said Vannevar Bush would be a great help if still alive...asked if he died. Said Bush was science advisor to Truman.

He said the people who were associated with the Research and Development Board (RDB) have scattered over the world. Working for the RDB was not a regular job for him. The RDB had a lot of power in those days, like a little Presidential Cabinet. That's why it was a dollar a year job (for him) (note: gave him prestige and also a clearance). Run by Carl Compton, former president of MIT, good friend of Eisenhower. It was set up by him. That is what OI was associated with around 1950 or a little later, he says.

Regarding himself: "There is something I should have done but didn't do. I had had a request to visit a site...(thinks request came from Wright Field or that the site was Wright Field)...regarding a fallen..a UFO and at that time could not go....tied up with personal business. But some of the men did go. Our headquarters were in old Navy temporary buildings on Constitution Ave. Some of the men went. I went to the office some time after they got back and talked to some of the guys who saw it. I wish I could have gone."

He was a evidently a consultant in missile guidance and worked only occasionally on special problems. He was on the guidance and control committee. He had his own private business.. a small laboratory. He did work for the government from time to time but still had to run his own lab. "I can't remember some of those guys. they were at least 30 years old at the time, maybe some around 40 or 50. Some of them must be around. You should try to contact them."

Bletchman called him after the OMNI article came out and asked if he would be willing to talk to people. He said he was being asked constantly about the stuff in the letter to Steinman. He keeps getting letters constantly from people who write sensational UFO stories. Sometimes they come by and see him. When he gets a chance he answers letters.

I asked him to relate his impression of what the men told

him they saw at Wright Patterson.

"My impression of what the men said who took the trip to Wright Field: the 'people' who operated those things were built different than we, they seemed to have no inertia, seemed to be like insects, maybe they were robots (this seemed to stick particularly in his mind)...that was all that was said .. (or all he could remember).

Problem is to find out who was on the RDB in those days... thinks it was Eisenhower who set it up and was killed by the next president

Thinks it was killed by Johnson.. not Kennedy who was a good friend of Sarbacher... Kennedy better educated... Johnson was nastier and less well educated. Kennedy an all American Boy... Johnson may have killed the RDB. It was a good idea...seems like Republicans have better educated cabinets, more imaginative.

Didn't know Wilburt Smith..or at least didn't seem to remember the name...said there were a lot of guys back then who talked to him....and has never read any UFO book including the ones written by people who have talked to him.

Said he would call me if he thinks of more (I gave number).

(NOTE: He died in the summer of 1986. Never did call back.)

Dear Mr. Steinman:

I am sorry I have taken so long in answering your letters. However, I have moved my office and have had to make a number of extended trips.

To answer your last question in your letter of October 14, 1983, there is no particular reason I feel I shouldn't or couldn't answer any or all of your questions. I am delighted to answer all of them to the best of my ability.

You listed some of your questions in your letter of September 12th. I will attempt to answer them as you had listed them.

1. Relating to my own experience regarding recovered flying saucers, I had no association with any of the people involved in the recovery and have no knowledge regarding the dates of the recoveries. If I had I would send it to you.

2. Regarding verification that persons you list were involved, I can only say this:

John von Neuman was definitely involved. Dr. Vannever Bush was definitely involved, and I think Dr. Robert Oppenheimer also.

My association with the Research and Development Board under Doctor Compton during the Eisenhower administration was rather limited so that although I had been invited to participate in several discussions associated with the reported recoveries, I could not personally attend the meetings. I am sure that they would have asked Dr. von Braun, and the others that you listed were probably asked and may or may not have attended. This is all I know for sure.

3. I did receive some official reports when I was in my office at the Pentagon but all of these were left there as at the time we were never supposed to take them out of the office.

4. I do not recall receiving any photographs such as you request so I am not in a position to answer.

5. I have to make the same reply as on No. 4.

I recall the interview with Dr. Brenner of the Canadian Embassy. I think the answers I gave him were the ones you listed. Naturally, I was more familiar with the subject matter under discussion, at that time. Actually, I would have been able to give more specific answers had I attended the meetings concerning the subject. You must understand that I took this assignment as a private contribution. We were called "dollar-a-year men." My first responsibility was the maintenance of my own business activity so that my participation was limited.

About the only thing I remember at this time is that certain materials reported to have come from flying saucer crashes were extremely light and very tough. I am sure our laboratories analyzed them very carefully.

There were reports that instruments or people operating these machines were also of very light weight, sufficient to withstand the tremendous deceleration and acceleration associated with their machinery. I remember in talking with some of the people at the office that I got the impression these "aliens" were constructed like certain insects we have observed on earth, wherein because of the low mass the inertial forces involved in operation of these instruments would be quite low.

I still do not know why the high order of classification has been given and why the denial of the existence of these devices.

I am sorry it has taken me so long to reply but I suggest you get in touch with the others who may be directly involved in this program.

I am not particularly upset about the MJ-12 informant piece. I was very irked at the MJ publishing Bob Todd's piece after telling me they would not and without notifying me in advance so that I could do a point by point response in the same issue.. as is done in IUR re Joe Nickell's garbage. Steinman aggravates me by not pointing out that contrary to what has been spread around he DID NOT discover or locate etc Sarbacher. ..I also think that some of the IUR pieces on Roswell have shorchanged the work that I did and even Bill Moore's work for that matter... and of course, I am not delighted by Jenny Randal's defamation in England in the Manchester Evening News.. hopefully the action will be settled shortly with a modest payment to Harry Harris and myself.

I am enclosing a copy of the Lazar piece from "For the People" I have not called Teller. He is very difficult to get in touch with according to a radio man from Berkeley. Also I just heard that he was asked about Lazar in an interview about other subjects and responded to the totally unexpected question by leaving the studio.. for whatever that is worth. I did get Lazar's Soc. Sec. Number. It has been checked. Somebody with that name does have that number.. for whatever good that does. I can't find it now.

I notice in the current FATE that Jerry Clark only gives me credit for noting that Lazar doesn't belong to the Amer. Phys. Soc. I also checked with MIT, Calif. Inst. of Tech., Calif. State Univ. Northridge and Pierce College. The first three knew nothing of Lazar.. Pierce said that Lazar had taken an electronics course pre 1977. I also checked with Persons who had city directories for Los Alamos, White Rock, Santa Fe for 1981-1985. There were no listings for Lazar .

Cooper seems to have gone totally off the wall. Bill Moore did NOT say he was a government agent. I categorically deny that I have ever worked for the US government in any capacity ever anywhere under any circumstances. His charge that I am a government agent is totally false. It is a flat out lie having no foundation. Is there any way to get this complete and unqualified denial on the same computer system? Cooper has lied about me before and also lied when he claimed to be quoting me about the nuclear reactors for aircraft engines.

To the best of my knowledge it is also untrue that Condor was John Lear.

I hear that Billy Goodman is off the air partly because Cooper went on and asked listeners to boycott advertisers on the radio station till Goodman got his earlier time slot back..

I am winding down my MJ-12 report. There will be some surprises. For one you may be interested in knowing that the book Questioned Documents referenced by Klass and Nickell as having been published in 1978 was actually written in 1910 and revised in 1929. Cameron: I understand that you spoke to this Robert Lazar in Vegas?

Friedman: No. I did not.

Cameron: You didn't actually talk to him.

Friedman: No. I talked about him. I saw a film that was done on KLAS-TV at John Lear's house. I also talked to George Knapp who's at the television station. I've been doing a lot of checking. I made calls to M.I.T. and they know nothing about him. I called Cal. Tech. and they knew nothing about him. I checked with the city people who had the directories for Los Alamos, White Rock, and Santa Fe for the time frame that he was supposedly at Los Alamos. They had no listing for him. I did talk to Bob Nathan about him briefly. Nathan had met him briefly over at JPL, and had no way of knowing whether he was or was not who he says he was. I even asked, although I never did get a response, in that direction. I have an old friend at Los Alamos. Now I talked to Knapp, and I did...he gave me Lazar's Social Security Number. I got access to someone who had access to a computer, and that number is listed in that name.

Cameron: Ya. I talked to Don.

Friedman: Ya. And I just got a note from Jerry indicating somebody - a party or parties unknown - has been doing some checking.

Cameron: Ya. I heard about that.

Friedman: I don't know who that party is. I don't know if that's you.

Cameron: It's a friend of Brad Sparks from what I hear.

Friedman: Oh, I'll bet I know who that is - that's probably Bob Quinn.

Cameron: He's in Ufology, but he's not in Ufology.

Friedman: Well, that could be.

Cameron: He's in Vegas.

Friedman: Well, that sounds like Bob. As soon as you said Brad... Brad had stayed...Brad's in a difficult situation. His mother was killed. This was a number of years ago, and his brother who is handicapped, was initially accused of murder. Brad got involved and was going through old bills. He was able to prove that the mother was on the telephone, at a time after the son was picked up special crew that picks them up. I don't know what he's got...

the condition where you shake... anyway. Brad moved from Berkeley down to L.A., and they've never caught the murderer. I believe that he's now married, and he has stayed out of touch. I got this from Bob as a matter of fact. I wanted to catch him, but he doesn't want anyone to know where he is. I was pretty close to Brad. I used to see him quite a bit... you know I lived very close to Berkeley.

So, I'm in the curious position. I have to get back to George Knapp, because he was doing more checking, and I had suggested some things. Now he did find a listing in a Los Alamos phone book.

Cameron: That was on the tape, where they found his name in the 1982 Los Alamos phone book.

Friedman: I don't know if that was on the tape. They may have made a second tape. My approach to these things is -trust but verify. If I can't find him, that doesn't prove that he isn't who he says that he is, but it means that I have no reason to say that he is who he says he is, or did what he says that he did, or that kind of thing. I talked to John about his sighting. They were eight miles away. It could have been an RTV. It could have been almost anything. So, it's in my grey basket. Now it's a very interesting story. I just got Jerry's letter - what is today Sunday - Friday. I'm caught in this crazy situation that I just don't know what to make of it. I was going to call George tomorrow, and see what his latest findings are. He actually went over to New Mexico, to Roswell, to dig into some of the stuff. He is supposed to be doing a special series. I presume that it's been on in Vegas. So, I really don't know what to tell you, other than no I didn't meet him. He doesn't belong to the American Physical Society either. I did check that.

Cameron: Is he claiming a Ph.D.?

Friedman: I'm not exactly sure what he's claiming. John Lear didn't have a lot of specifics. He said "well, he knew how to explain things, but he couldn't tell me." I don't think it's playing games, but it was terribly frustrating for me. I tried to stress to him. I said "Look. John this is a very sensational story. People have made up stories in the past. I need to try to check him out. I'd love to stand behind the story, if I can have some reason to say it's true." But certainly the first step is - this guy - someone should be doing some of this kind of work.

Cameron: Some people were saying that what he was saying didn't seem to exhibit the type of background that he was claiming.

Friedman: Well, the newspaper article that was about him, in the Los Alamos weekly paper, showed him driving a jet powered honda. In that same issue there was an article about Edward Teller. That establishes that at least he was in that town at that time, but there's no record in the city directory of where he lived, by

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that name. When you hear a guy's from M.I.T...and the funny thing is... both the M.I.T. registrar and the one at Cal Tech say that they get phone calls all the time from people checking on people who claim that they went here, and who didn't. I was shocked. Both of them told me. So, he could have gone to school under another name. Now George Knapp supposedly had a name for a community college in California where he had gone early on. As I said the Security Card number checks out, but I don't know what that means.

Cameron: That's what Don says. He has just given a number that checks.

Friedman: Ya. Anyone can get a Social Security Number.

Cameron: He hasn't named any of his superiors yet. He hasn't named this Dennis guy yet?

Friedman: No. I haven't heard the name Dennis before.

Cameron: According to the tape that I saw, in May they had him darkened out with just his voice. He was using the name Dennis. In the latest tape he stated that the reason that he had used the name Dennis is that was the name of his superior. Dennis phoned him up and said "Now you know what we're going to do to you?"

Friedman: I did hear that he was threatened, but I didn't know that there was a second tape on the air.

Cameron: This is a two hour tape, where Lazar appears for about 15 minutes. Now I have heard that there is a second tape that is two hours of just Lazar.

Friedman: There was another reason for doubt come to think of it. I talked to Linda Howe because when she was in Colorado, somehow Lazar was involved, and there was somebody going to come up about a recent mutilation case. They were all set to come up, so she checked around with her sources, and could find nothing. It turns out that they weren't right there, and they weren't going to come up. It was all fowled up, and she found that very strange that something was inconsistent with how they did things. So that raised another question, and just made it more important. I'm a UFO fanatic, who's presentation would be as factual as a Steven Spielberg movie, who subscribes to the notion that all we've learned from having bodies on ice for the past 42 years is that they like strawberry icecream... a disciple of the theory that a saucer crashed in New Mexico, and that we made a pact with aliens. Well considering that I have staunchly opposed strawberry ice cream, and pacts with aliens. Anyway. I've been running around, and now I'm home for a month. (continued)

Dear Grant:

Thanks much for your letter and enclosures of June 30 which arrive July 8. I trust you kept a copy of your letter and will try to deal with each point in order.

1. I don't know what you mean about leaks about Walker. Clearly Fenwick does NOT have Walker's name only the details you gave him. I will not enlighten him. I first paid attention to Walker when Steinman mentioned him to either Bill or me. As you will recall I had contacted Arthur Bray after his Toronto MUFON paper to find out more about Sarbacher whom I found fairly quickly by checking in a library in various directories. I still don't know why Arthur hadn't located him. I was the first to contact Sarbacher whom I found to be friendly but with NO first hand information. I was the first to visit him as well. I shared my info with Bill (Moore) who probably unfortunately shared it with Steinman. I dug out some goobies on Walker finding that he had the right kind of background and located him. My immediate response to my phone conversation with him is that he knew more than he was telling but that I knew no way of getting it out of him over the phone or by letter. Possibly in person. I don't recall even mentioning Walker in my ATI request and don't recall your letter asking for more info. I am sorry I didn't respond if I got it. Some of mail wasn't forwarded when I moved here from 110 Kings College in January 1985.

I have been to Washington many times. I certainly do NOT have files on all those possibly linked to MJ-12. I do have bios on the original MJ-12 group and will enclose some input. I am enclosing one detailed listing on Walker. I tend to rely on library biographical information-- Who's Who, Men of Science, Dictionary of Biography etc...

You mention 5 or 6 contacts with Walker including mine. I know nothing about the others. I would expect Steinman and possibly Zechel.. know idea who the others are.

You mention Captain Donald Goodspeed, as a possibly beneficial contact. Can you give me more info so that I can try to locate him? Was he military or airline? Where did he live? When did he know Smith? Have you asked Smith's son or wife? Any middle initial?

2. I know nothing about the secret meetings at WPAFB. As you know Len Stringfield has not investigated the veracity of almost all of his stories nor the backgrounds of his people. He was a primary target for disinformation. I saw Linda Howe a week ago. I don't know whether she was shown disinformation or factual info or a mix. I had sent Len a lot about MJ-12 but have had no response so I also don't know anything about any 1988 meetings... though I am interested.

3. Sarbacher mentioned Fred Darwin but that he hadn't seen him for many many years and had no idea where he was. I located Darwin, spoke with him, sent him material. He wrote Sarbacher.. old buddies etc. Unfortunately Steinman was given the info by Bill and tried to pressure both people (Darwin and Sar.). Darwin did give me some names of people and some comments about them. I may be able to find my notes though it will take some effort. I have not been in touch with Darwin recently.

Nothing is easy at the Archives. It would take a lot of work to dig out the Missile

Committee files. An Archive is NOT a library. The finders guides are usually woefully inadequate and incomplete. Nobody knows what is where. Loads of file folders but few listings of contents. One has items like "SECRET Correspondence 1947-1953 5 feet." I did push them for the JRDB files a few years back. There were over 340 file boxes that had just been gone through for classification review. Eventually they found a thick booklet listing materials but with no way to know in which box which file was. Many of the listings were very cryptic. Remember there is great understaffing at the Archives and no computerization of any of this material. In addition material is scattered all over the place. Roughly the equivalent of taking file cabinets from hundreds of people and emptying the files into archive boxes and turning the truck loads over to the archives and then having them stored inside closed access vaults awaiting a classification review.

I hope to get to Washington in October again, so could possibly find time to check. But please send a copy of the letter telling you about the 927,000 pages so I can plan in advance. They are not nearly as well organized as the Ike or Truman Libraries or the Library of Congress Manuscript Division. Note they bring the boxes requested. No browsing.

4. I will see what I can do about the files of Margaret Chase Smith.

5. There have been thousands of papers published on superconductivity in hundreds of journals and magazines and dozens of conferences. There are now probably at least a dozen newsletters being published. I am enclosing a few items, but I need more info as to what you are seeking. I am enclosing a very recent Popular Science article on Stealth technology and have met Sweetman who did the book. Perhaps you could tell me the "bizarre unpublished statement by Smith" so that I could try to interpret it? I have been following the flight and underwater aspects of superconductivity for 27 years or so.

6. I don't have the addresses of Fournet, Chop, and Futch but have left a message for Bill Pitts in Ft. Smith, Arkansas, who arranged the Eureka Springs Conference at which the former were present. I cannot be sure that Chop would have known of the Bush connection. Remember that the Smith memo was TOP SECRET. I should run the MJ-12 stuff by them anyway. Remember that it indicates that there were MJ-12 Moles in Blue Book, Grudge and Sign...

7.a. I have no idea as to the legitimacy of the Schweitzer letter. Sounds like typical polite response... mistakes are common all over the place.

b. I know nothing about what General Arnold might have said re Interstellar ^{war} world. I don't have that issue of Focus at hand either.

c. I know nothing more about Bush's comment re the half of it. how accurate is the quote?

d. I will enclose items re Reagan, Gorbachev and alien Invaders..

I notice that no mention is made of the supposed notes from a supposed meeting of MJ-12. Has anybody seen these-- presumably connected with Walker?? Have you checked all NYT indexes re Walker for names of associates? Have you been in touch with Darwin or should I try to go down that pike again? Remember that I didn't have the MJ-12 stuff during most of these contacts which would have certainly changed my approach.

I will send along my "Debunking the Debunker" piece.. due out in IUR mid August... and will look for your response....

PPPS. I have Michaud's fine article. Was published. I referenced it.. not secret at all. CVK often gets confused and jumps to conclusions. STF
