Available sources indicate [redacted] matriculated at the University of Washington, January, 1956. Parents, [redacted] and [redacted] all of [redacted] Seattle, where they have resided for the past 20 years. No discreditable information [redacted]

[redacted] or pertinent references in the files of this office concerning [redacted] or his parents. [redacted]

Concerning [redacted] letter of August 2, 1956 to the Director and the questions posed therein. [redacted] was interviewed on August 23, 1956 by Special Agents [redacted] and [redacted] in the presence of his parents at their request. [redacted] was informed that GEORGE A. ADAMSKI had been contacted by agents of this Bureau merely to suggest he desist in inferring that the FBI cleared his material on space travel. [redacted] was informed that this Bureau has no authority to clear any organization, publication, or individual, and certainly has no authority to comment on space travel. It was specifically pointed out to [redacted] that this was the sole reason for agents of this Bureau contacting ADAMSKI.

[redacted] inferred that he has tentative arrangements to publish the results of his research and findings, and was disappointed that he was unable to obtain the answers to his questions in writing, but stated that he now understood the Bureau's position in this matter.
