JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF CITE TECHNICAL OBSTACLES TO COMMUNICATION WITH "UNKNOWN AERIAL OBJECTS"

No successful method of communicating with UFOs has been developed, the Joint Chiefs of Staff have informed NICAP. The official statement dated May 5, 1958, was signed by Colonel James C. Sherrill, USAF, Executive to the JCS Chairman, General Nathan F. Twining.

"No effective means," stated Colonel Sherrill, "have been developed for the establishment of communications by radio or otherwise with unknown aerial objects. The technical obstacles involved in such an endeavor, I am sure, are quite obvious to you."

NICAP's inquiry to General Twining included two other important questions:

● IS JANAP 146 in force, so that airline pilots and any others reporting UFOs under this Joint Chiefs of Staff communications plan are forbidden to reveal the contents of any such reports?

The JCS answer: "In answer to your question, JANAP 146 is still in force. Its purpose is to provide uniform communications instructions for the reporting by airborne and waterborne sources of information which in the opinion of the observer is vital to the security of this country and requires prompt action by the U. S. Armed Forces."

● Since the Joint Chiefs of Staff undoubtedly are aware of the UFO problem, have they ordered any JCS investigation or evaluation of unsolved and fully verified cases?

The JCS answer by Colonel Sherrill: "The Joint Chiefs of Staff are, of course, aware of the instances of UFOs; however, a 'JCS investigation' is not considered necessary since all reports of UFOs are thoroughly investigated and evaluated by the Air Force."

A NICAP request for an appointment with General Twining — to discuss the UFO problem — was denied because of his crowded schedule and because, Colonel Sherrill stated, "It is felt that officials of the Air Force are in the best position to assist you in furthering the aims to which you referred."

(The aims mentioned were described to General Twining as follows: "We believe that a frank and open approach will soon end the confusion, misunderstanding and frequent ridicule attached to the UFO investigation, and will quickly bring about a helpful cooperation by most of the American public and the press.")

NICAP Comment: Despite the refusal of an interview with General Twining, this JCS letter is an important addition to official statements on UFOs. The answer to the communication question seems especially significant.

Instead of following the usual Air Force policy line that UFOs do not exist, the JCS letter cites technical obstacles to

communication with such objects. This does not definitely say that such an endeavor has been made, but the door is left wide open for such an inference.

In 1953 the Air Force had said that to admit any such attempt would be an official admission that they believed the UFOs to be real.

The JCS answer regarding JANAP 146 plainly indicates that the Joint Chiefs of Staff consider the UFOs as a serious problem, vital to the security of the United States. The phrase "requiring prompt action by the U. S. Armed Forces" will undoubtedly be interpreted by some as a hint of UFO hostility, but the preface "in the opinion of the observer" should be carefully considered here.

The statement that the Joint Chiefs are "aware of the instances of UFOs" is peculiar, since the intended meaning of "instances" is not clear. The JCS Chairman General Twining stated in 1954 that the Air Force had the "best brains in the country" working on this problem. Though

UNEXPLAINED SIGNALS FROM JUPITER EQUAL H-BOMB IN FORCE

Powerful radio emanations from the planet Jupiter — coming from an energy source equivalent to an H-bomb, are being received here on earth — the National Bureau of Standards has revealed. The location of the source has been accurately determined as to longitude, but its true nature and that of the signals remain unexplained.

The signals, says an NBS scientist, are received on two frequencies — one at about 18 megacycles, the other at about 20 megacycles. One odd discovery made by the NBS laboratory at Boulder, Colorado, is that the signals are never received simultaneously but come in distinctly separate periods.

Details of Jupiter's radio emanations were disclosed by Roger M. Gallet, an NBS scientist associated with the Radio Propagation Physics Division at Boulder. The signals, he said, come in bursts of a few seconds duration. Usually there is a series lasting several minutes, followed by a period of complete silence.

Gallet stressed the fact that most of the radiation is within a narrow band width of about 0.6 megacycles. This indicates, he said, that it may be produced by resonances in the planet's atmosphere caused by shock waves. If this is the answer, waves would have intensities as high as those of the great San Francisco earthquake. In a more modern comparison, he said that the sources must have energies as high as that of a hydrogen bomb — about 5 million tons of TNT.

The NBS observation of these signals for almost eight years shows the sources are fixed longitudinally. The observations are so precise that they have been used for accurate determination of Jupiter's rotation. The rotation rate shows that Jupiter's day is 9 hours, 55 minutes, 29.5 seconds long, by earth time measurements.

The Bureau of Standards research, said Gallet, also indicates that Jupiter is a solid hydrogen ball about 93,000 miles in diameter, surrounded by an atmosphere of

COAST GUARD SILENT ON AIR FORCE EXPLANATION OF SEBAGO CASE

Coast Guard officers have to date remained strangely silent regarding Air Force "explanations" of the SEBAGO sighting last November.

On November 5, 1958, experienced radarmen aboard this Coast Guard cutter reported tracking a UFO as it maneuvered around their ship in the Gulf of Mexico. At one time a speed of over 1000 mph was indicated on the radarscope. Visual confirmation also was reported by two Coast Guard deck officers.

Ignoring official verification of this case by Coast Guard Headquarters, the AF in effect branded all the witnesses as incompetent. In a Pentagon press release the Air Force declared the radarmen and deck officers had been confused by ordinary aircraft.

An inquiry by NICAP has been sent to Vice Admiral A. C. Richmond, Coast Guard Commandant, asking if he agrees that the SEBAGO radar operators were incompetent and the deck officers were confused to the extent of reporting ordinary aircraft as a "round, glowing object."

To date no answer has been received. If renewed inquiries still meet silence, it would appear that the Commandant has orders to back up the Air Force claim—humiliating as it must be to permit ridicule of trained Coast Guard personnel.

REQUEST TO MEMBERS: Please let us know of any informative UFO discussions on local radio or television stations, especially those which contribute new, verified UFO sighting reports. Frequently local stations carry reports on UFOs which never reach the press wires and these local sightings often are an important part of the entire picture.

he said there was no positive proof of UFOs' reality, he added at that time, "If they come from Mars and there is a world and a civilization that far ahead of us, I don't think we have anything to worry about."

No further explanation of these words was ever made public. Nor since that date has General Twining ever made any other statement on UFOs. For that reason, the JCS letter—undoubtedly written with his complete approval—should carry extra weight.

It is encouraging to know that—at the very least—the Joint Chiefs do not sarcastically brush off the UFO problem, which is the treatment given by the present public information spokesman in the Air Force.

hydrogen gas with a temperature of minus 189 degrees (-189°) Fahrenheit.

There have been various other theories about Jupiter's composition; but if the NBS findings are correct, this apparently would rule out intelligent life as we know it. However, this would not rule out other intelligent forms of life which had evolved to exist under such conditions. Besides adjusting to the low temperature and hydrogen atmosphere, such beings would be accustomed to the tremendous gravity forces of this huge planet. An earthling—without some artificial device to offset these high G forces—could not exist on Jupiter, even if he conquered the temperature and atmosphere problems.

All of these factors should heighten the interest in the strange signals from Jupiter. They may be from natural sources; most radio astronomers believe that the majority if not all of such emanations are of natural origin. But this leaves completely unexplained the mysterious, tremendous shock waves, the fixed location sources, the precise wavelengths, and the alternating periods when the signals are heard.

If there is intelligence behind these radio emanations, it does not necessarily prove that Jupiter is inhabited, except for brief intervals perhaps. The terrific power described by the Bureau of Standards expert is far more than that required for communication on Jupiter or to spacecraft in its vicinity. Signals of such vast power and range might serve as radio beacons for space navigators—either set up by a possible Jupiter race or set up by another planet race—and serviced as required. Unless this space radio beacon suggestion is the answer—temporarily assuming intelligent signals—then these long range signals could be intended to reach distant planets such as the earth, in an attempt to establish communication. This could mean the existence of an intelligent race on Jupiter—advanced in communication methods, but not necessarily as to space travel.

The Jupiter report recalls a similar one by Dr. J. D. Kraus, well known Ohio State University radio astronomer. About four years ago Dr. Kraus stated he had received a new type of signals from Venus almost like telegraphic code. His statement was widely published but Dr. Kraus was later quoted as denying that he meant the signals were artificial.

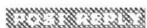

the other material was obtained while
Smith would wake up in the morning

Musgrave tells of the experiment run on anti-

Government secret Project

In January 1972, the Department of Interplanetary Affairs was created, to research into the scientific investigation of UFOs and attempt to contact UFO occupants if possible. Extensive files on reports of UFO landings, sightings, and contacts in Hawaii were soon accumulated, and it was discovered that many UFO researchers desired our reports. We began to trade data, and were amazed when former officials of secret government or military intelligence agencies came to our office, and offered to trade us what THEY KNEW for what we knew. The information was often classified TOP SECRET and beyond, they admitted government and military UFO secrecy, and much of the information alarmed us then! This research was so startling he could possibly have been assassinated for releasing it, so it was not available to us until he died. PROJECT MAGNET has been able to work with Canadian scientists who had continued working on inventions of Nikola Tesla, one of the most prominent scientists in history. Tesla, who invented the AC/DC electrical current, helped invent radar and much military technology, was the holder of hundreds of successful patented invention. He had told some associates and friends he had invented an interplanetary communications device with ideas given to him by Venusians he was in contact with then. People who heard these conversations often laughed, yet Project Magnet took Tesla seriously. This report details a formerly secret experimental UFO landing site built by the Canadian government during their attempts to contact UFOs their air Force had monitored in the skies. Former Canadian Defense Minister, Paul Hellyear, later publicly admitted that project existed. However, he did not mention what Smith reported...the project had actually detected a real UFO with their scientific equipment, and later a scientific research group he directed established communications with a landed interplanetary ship from what their pilots said was Venus. Tesla's closest scientific assistant at one time, Arthur Matthews, was involved in this contact. The Project Magnet report added that Matthews had been trying to complete some of Tesla's incomplete inventions, when the Venusians helped him with instructions on finishing that work. The report also details several inventions the Venusians gave to Project Magnet through Dr. Matthews' committee, which were tested and worked perfectly. The Venusians were also seriously concerned about our environmental damage and danger from nuclear testing and fossil fuels, warned the government to try to stop these practices, and offered alternative non-polluting nearly-free energy systems that government leaders, kept in power by multi-billion dollar oil, gas, coal, and war industries all rejected for "Economic reasons."

WILBERT B. SMITH -- A UFO CONTACTEE?

In the annals of UFO history, the name of Wilbert B. Smith is associated with a project report written in 1950 by Smith to his superiors in the U.S. Government, concerning U.S. government secrecy on UFOs. Saying his inspiration came from Dr. Robert Sarbacher, Smith wrote, in part:

"The matter is the most highly classified subject in the United States government, rating higher even than the H-bomb. It is well known to exist. It is a secret. It is unknown but concentrated effort is being made by the U.S. Government by Dr. Vannevar Bush. The matter is considered by the United States authorities to be of great significance."

As a result of this information and Smith's accompanying recommendations, the U.S. Government launched its own "Project Magnet" a few months later. The intent of which was to study possible attributes and applications of "magnet" technology. Smith was appointed "engineer in charge." For several years, Project Magnet collected a variety of UFO reports and related various studies of UFO-related technological effects. Along the way, Smith produced a number of secret memoranda in which he stated his belief that they were of extraterrestrial origin.

In the years since, the Canadian government has tried to downplay Project Magnet and Smith's work in particular. However, the release of numerous formerly secret documents leave no doubt that the foregoing is true. [A good summary of Smith's work can be found in the book "Above Top Secret" by Timothy Good.]

On 10/17/97

letter dated October 27, the writer claims that Smith was apparently a UFO contactee. To ISCNI's knowledge, this claim has not previously been made in

public. The writer has requested anonymity (he has provided personal information to CNI News editor Michael Lindemann) but has granted permission to reproduce excerpts of his letters in CNI News. If any reader has additional information on Wilbert B. Smith, please send it directly to ISCNI.

The following is quoted from the letters sent to ISCNI:

"Our connection with W. P. [sic] Smith is like a fairy tale. At the time I was giving lectures on UFOs, and had heard of Smith, but of course he knew nothing of my activities. One night we were working on a medical hypnosis project with a group of doctors (my wife as deep trance subject). Suddenly, without warning, my wife was pulled into a deep vortex. When she came out at the other end, she was given a detailed formula, which she was told was the time sequences as experienced on another planet. (Such as our 365-day year, 12 months, 24 hours, etc.) No other information was received.

"What do you do when something like that shows up in a medical research project? Well, on a hunch, the next day I took the FIRST HALF of the formula, and sent it by telegram to [Wilbert] Smith. Knowing his stature and position in the Canadian government, I did not expect to hear from him. A few days later I got a special delivery airmail from him. He said, 'The information you sent means nothing to me and I have referred it to TOP SIDE.'

"The very next day I received another special delivery airmail from him, and it contained the entire formula -- the half that I had sent him, and the half that I had not sent to him. We decided that in some way, we were being instructed to work together, and we did from then on. He came to Kansas City on one occasion, and we sent to Oklahoma on an investigation together.

"When [Smith] first was assigned to "Project Magnet," he started hearing from a young chap in Canada who had been born blind. The man had spent most of his life with his wireless and Smith said that he could probably receive Morse Code faster than anyone else in the world. The man was receiving bursts of code that were messages that he was supposed to give to Smith. Smith used his facilities, and with direction finders, determined that the bursts of code were not COMING FROM ANYWHERE ON EARTH, BUT FROM SPACE! After a few months the code stopped, and Smith received messages from then on thru direct telepathic impression. They would give him information on a specific subject, and then give him instructions on how to manufacture a device to prove to himself that their information was valid.

"At one time Smith called and told me to look for small burnt spots on my lawn or shrub outside the house, anytime we had a UFO project going on inside. Sure enough, we found the spots. He said they were made by grapefruit-size sensors that were planted in areas of UFO research to record the proceedings in the house. We found the burnt areas on numerous occasions.

"One time they told him that our earth has fault areas in the magnetic force lines. If one of our planes flies thru a fault area, and the plane already has a component that is under severe strain, the relaxing of the magnetic fields at the time of passage thru the area will allow the molecules to literally tear apart, thus a crash. Then they taught him how to make a device to detect the fault areas. On several occasions, when visiting a crash area, his device detected magnetic faults, as described by the alien intelligence. As far as I know, he was in constant contact long after his year [sic] with PROJECT MAGNET, and probably until his death.

"When talking with Smith in those day, he talked to me about his alien contacts in the same manner that he would have talked about any local group of people that he was constantly in touch with. I wish I had recordings of

r conversations, but at that time it seemed so natural we made no attempt
o preserve them. Also, in those days, all we had were primitive wire

recorders to preserve our conversations. We got tape about the time of our
initial contact with him, and it was very expensive. My impression was that
his contacts were on a very regular basis, even possibly daily, for a long
period of time. I do remember him receiving information about earth time
standing still for someone traveling at interplanetary speeds. Then they
told him how to set up a rocket experiment with an earth time piece, and
with that he confirmed that at the speeds his experiment achieved, the clock
in the rocket did not show as much expired time as the clocks that were set
at the same time when it was sent up. In almost every case, when they taught
him something, they gave him a back up experiment to prove to himself that
their information was valid. He had personally observed many of the
grapefruit-size remote controlled sensors that I mentioned."

Editor's Note: If this information about Wilbert Smith is true, then one of
the most reputable sources of information on early U.S. government UFO
secrecy turns out to be a UFO contactee who claimed years of telepathic
contact with extraterrestrials. ISCNI hopes that this information can be
corroborated by other sources in the near future.

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
