Thank you for your reply to my letter about the Memorial Award.

The information you sent me did not state whether the papers must be original for this purpose or whether papers already written would be accepted. Nor was the time of writing mentioned. In view of the time factor involved, I could not prepare a new paper now, but I wonder if a detailed brief I wrote earlier this year for submission to the Canadian Senate Committee on Science Policy might be an acceptable entry. This paper has not yet been published but will be published within the next month or so by our Queen's Printer (our equivalent of the U.S. Government Printing Office) as part of the Committee Hearings.

My brief is titled "Science, Society and the UFO" and is fully documented throughout. It not only details the impact of the UFO, and scientific attitudes towards UFOs, on Society, but suggests a new avenue for investigation.

If this entry would be acceptable, I could forward a published copy (or more if required) as soon as it is off the press.
