Dear Brian:

Thanks for your letter of November 4. I am sorry to hear that CAPRO has folded. It is the old problem though - one key person holds a whole organization together. When he leaves, the whole thing collapses. There just aren't enough keen, interested and willing people like yourself around. And not enough who maintain their interest during the "lulls".

Just a point I wanted to clarify for you. You indicated in your letter that you are under the impression that the entire chunk of metal was turned over to NRC. This is incorrect. I gave NRC a piece weighing only a couple of pounds (estimated weight of total chunk - 3000 pounds!) Apart from many small bits chopped off, the mass is essentially intact and still in private hands. Analyses are being conducted by independent labs (non-government) as well, so that we may compare the results of the various tests in due course.
