Dear Mr. Hoville:

I am writing in response to your letter of 9 June in which you requested a copy of the Robertson Panel Report on Unidentified Flying Objects (the report is often referred to as the Durant Report, named after F.C. Durant who prepared the final report). Enclosed is the Durant Report (24 pages), complete with Tabs A, B and C, all of which have been declassified. Each Tab consists of two pages. The Durant Report is the summation of the history, meetings and conclusions of the Scientific Advisory Panel on UFO's convened by OSI, CIA.

In order to avoid confusion in reading the report, let me point out two errors which were not detected in the initial proofreading. On page six there is a statement in parentheses which reads "A copy of the final report is appended as Tab C." The statement should have read "is appended as Tab A." If you will refer to the Index, you will note that Tab A is referred to as "Report of Panel", and Tab A - you will notice - is so entitled.

The other typing error which was made in reversing the titles of Tabs B and C in the Index. If you will make the correction on page six to read "Tab A" to coincide with the Index and then reverse the Tab letters B and C in the Index, your copy of the report will be in correct sequence.

If you follow literature on unidentified flying objects, I am sure you have a copy of Scientific Study of Unidentified Flying Objects, published by Bantam Books, YZ4747, 1969. You will note that the Index page of the Durant Report on page 905 contains the same error in reversing Tabs B and C. Further, you will read on page 908 the same error of the copy
