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ADDENDUM TO INFORMATION CONCERNING THE BSRA

The BSR is not a commercial set-up and has not as yet paid any profit over the costs of operation. Operating costs include lease on two office rooms at \$50.00 per month, the payment of two part-time clerical workers, the minor personal expenses of the Director (not a salary), expenditures for supplies - paper, ink, and the larger mimeographing which cannot be handled on the office equipment.

The BSRA are not book dealers, and do not send out lists of books or other publications for advertising purposes.

BSR Hdqrs act as a distribution center for certain types of information, and as coordinating various investigations into 'borderland' phenomena. Funds for carrying on BSR activities are received in varying amounts from 'members', who in turn receive one or more mimeo. publications, various bulletins and releases.

BSR Associates are widely scattered over the United States, with a few in England, France, and Mexico. BSR Hdqrs. prints and distributes about 900 copies of the bi-monthly ROUND ROBIN, but the 'contact' or pass-around circulation probably reaches 2500-3000 names. The current issue (Jan. Feb., 1956) is Vol. XI No. 5

Information concerning BSR publications is usually sent only on request, but no charge is made for it and no propaganda of any sort is carried on.
