Dear Arthur:

Many thanks for your letter and so happy to hear that you will be able to visit us on Sunday, September 28.

We were very interested and quite excited to hear that you have a testing device invented by Tesla which will be able to detect if the Chunk of Hardware was ever in Outer Space and that you would like to test it out on the mass of metal on site. Anyway, let me know by letter which arrangements you prefer, but if you go on your own, be sure to be at the Buchanans at 2 p.m. sharp.
