> > outline your interest with Mrs. Murl Smith, and the Ottawa Flying Saucer

> > Mr. Beatty is a name that I am not familiar with. Did he ever publish
> > his impressions of what had occurred with Smith? I am quite interested in

> > these stories should all be put down somewhere for reference before all
> > the original people who were actually involved are dead.

> > For example in my contacts with Murl she told me that she planned to
> > write a book detailing all her trips with Wilbert to visit all the UFO
> > groups in the US. Murl never did, and now all that is lost.
> >
> > I will have to look up the reference that I have to Smith having ACCESS
> > to the bodies, but it involved him allowing someone else to see the
> > bodies. There is no reference to Smith, himself, seeing them, but if he
> > got someone else into the room, we can assume that he too saw them. (I

> > I was aware of the involvement of Dr. Matthews, but I have never heard
> > the story of exactly what he and Smith did together. I know he was
> > involved because in his writing he talks about contacts with AFFA which
> > is the same alien Smith (and Mrs. Swan) were in contact with. I
> > believe Matthews was from Quebec. Did any of the Montreal people have
> > contact with him?

> > As to Smith's friend who was involved in the experiments - was his first
> > name ART?

> > Now as to the critical issue of the bodies and Roswell. The Roswell
> > name and case did not become popular till Friedman did the original
> > interviews of some of the witnesses in 1978. The Sarbacher notes mention
> > Smith being told that the Aztec crash was the legitimate crash.

> > Was the word Roswell used? I would like a second clarification on the

> > bodies, as the grey aliens did not become popular till the Hill
> > abduction. There is even a story which Mrs. Hill told me, that after her
> > abduction -Keyhoe brought in Mrs Swan to talk to her to help her with
> > her experience. Mrs. Swan refused to do it because in her opinion Mrs.
> > Hill had been contacted by the "evil ones", and AFFA was one of the good
> > ones (ie blonds). As far as I knew smith always considered the " Boys
> > topside" to be good, and therefore blond aliens. How much Smith knew
> > about the greys is not recorded anywhere that I have seen.

> > thus my interest in you clarifying what Murl said about the bodies. When
> > I spoke to her she constantly referred to AFFA, but never really
> > described him.

> > John Musgrave had a contact (possibly Buchanan who no longer wishes to
> > talk, and had cancer six years ago when I last contacted him) that Smith
> > had viewed a downed saucer in a hanger in Washington DC. This however
> > does not mess with the usual locations mentioned for the storage of the
> > hardware.

> > Hopefully some of the stories that I have heard help you. The references
> > that you made are important and I would like to clarify them if at all
> > possible.

> > Unfortunately Gordon Betty has also passed away some few years
> ago . Thanks for reminding me of Murl's name. I gather from your note
