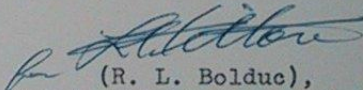
Dear Sir:

Your letter of December 29, 1970 to the Minister of Transport with respect to unidentified flying objects (UFO's) has been forwarded here for reply.

The Aeronautics Act and Air Regulations that govern safety of flight in Canada apply to all aircraft while operating in controlled airspace. These regulations are considered adequate for the purpose. I am advised, however, that we have no evidence of UFO's intruding in controlled airspace.

An alternative, of course, is action by military aircraft operating under authority of the Minister of National Defence. Since we are not in a position to comment in this area you may care to communicate with the Department of National Defence at Bldg. A, 125 Elgin St., Ottawa, Ontario.
