Dear Brian:

Thank you for your letter of August 12th. I am not at all surprised that you were overburdened with admin work with CAPRO. I do not know how you managed it all. It certainly must have kept you busy.

I have been having one devil of a time trying to see Millman again. This explains my lack of communication to you. I have been trying to see him for two and a half months but he has been away constantly, either in Europe, on holidays, or through illness. Right now he is tied up for two weeks on the big international astronomical meeting in Ottawa (URSI). I have a long list of matters to discuss with him, and I do not care to see any of his underlings as I know I will not receive any satisfaction from them. I am not even certain I will receive any from Millman. Strange, that even though I am right here in Ottawa, I have one devil of a time seeing him.

The Neal case from Victoria is one of the matters I want to discuss with Millman, so I have nothing to offer you at present. With respect to your letter of June 29th, on the landings near Westmeath, etc. I had hoped to be able to get there myself but have been unable. Hank McKay of Agincourt, Ontario, was up there again the other day, and visited me yesterday on his return. He has some worthwhile supporting data for you which you should receive soon.

With respect to the Senate Committee, I did not receive the opportunity to appear in person to answer questions, which I regret. They apparently had so many briefs on all subjects, that they were forced to cut it short in order to work on their report to the cabinet. However, my brief was passed to all senators on the committee, and is to be published in the Proceedings, very shortly. It was the only brief presented on UFOs. The Report to the Cabinet is supposed to be finished in November, so we will then see whether they have included any recommendations on this subject, or whether they have ignored it. As promised, I will send you a copy of the published brief as soon as available.
