### Biography

Frank Scully (1892-1964) was a well known author, journalist, humorist, and political activist. Educated at Columbia University, he began his career as a reporter on the *New York Sun*. Mr. Scully moved to Europe in the 1920s and did not return to the United States until 1933.

While in Europe he wrote a column for *Variety*, authored books, and handled publicity for Rex Ingram Pictures and Metro-Goldwyn-Meyer films in France. Once back in the United States, he moved to Los Angeles to work for 20th Century fox. He was a contributor to *Esquire*, *Reader's Digest*, *Catholic Digest*, and other national periodicals. He wrote a regular column for *Variety*, *The Epic News*, *United Progressive News*, and *Hollywood Press Times*.

Mr. Scully was a three-time nominee for the California legislature and appointed to the post of Secretary of the California Department of Institutions in 1938. Throughout his life, he gave his time and talent to philanthropic organizations. He was a founding member of the Los Angeles Newspapers Guild, founder of the Los Angeles Humane Society, a president of the Muscular Dystrophy Foundation of California and a long time member of the Hollywood Democratic Club. He received a Fiftieth Anniversary Medal from the Columbia University School of Journalism and was a papal knight in the Orders of St. Elizabeth, and of St. Gregory.

His books include *Bernard Shaw*, *The Fun in Bed Series for Convalescents*, *Rogue's Gallery*, *Behind the Flying Saucers*, *Blessed Mother Goose*, *Cross My Heart*, *This Gay Knight*, and *In Armor Bright*.

### Series Description

The Frank Scully Papers are arranged in 6 series:

Series I. Unidentified Flying Objects, Subject Files 1926-1985. 2.95 cubic ft. (6 document boxes, 1 slim document box). Arranged alphabetically by physical description. Includes audio tapes regarding propulsion of spacecraft, and fan mail, newsletters, newspaper and magazine clippings, notes, pamphlets, magazines, and sheet music regarding flying saucers and fire balls.

Series II. California Department of State Institutions, Files of the Secretary 1937-1941. 0.6 cubic ft. (1 1/3 document boxes). Arranged chronologically. Includes correspondence, memoranda, reports, legal depositions, and newspaper clippings regarding Frank Scully's responsibilities as secretary and his disagreements with Dr. Aaron Rosanoff, the head of the department.

Series III. California Politics, Campaign Files 1934-1948. 0.3 cubic ft. (2/3 document box). Arranged chronologically. Includes campaign materials, correspondence and newspaper clippings regarding Frank Scully's candidacy for Assemblyman for the 57th district, and Democratic platforms in general.

Series IV. Manuscript Files, 1929-1963. 4.75 cubic ft. (10 document boxes, 1 slim document box). Arranged alphabetically by title. Books, articles, plays, stories, and columns written by Frank Scully, unless otherwise indicated.

Series V. Correspondence, 1924-1964. 5.2 cubic ft. (11 document boxes, 1 slim document box). Arranged alphabetically. Between Frank Scully and friends, family, professional associated, publishers, and editors regarding Frank Scully's columns, articles, books, social problems, and politics.

Series VI. Printed Material, 1931-1962. 0.45 cubic ft. (1 document box, 1 slim document box). Arranged alphabetically. Includes magazine articles and newspaper columns written by Frank Scully.

### Scope and Content

The Frank Scully Papers, 1924-1985, contain useful material for those interested in the UFO phenomenon. There are extensive clippings and newsletters regarding UFO sightings. The fan mail is primarily from professional people discussing spacecraft design.

The California Department of State Institution and California Politics files provide insight into the political corruption in California during the 1930s and 1940s, and Frank Scully's efforts to improve social conditions and clean up California politics.

The manuscript files contain drafts of books that Frank Scully had ghost written for celebrities, drafts of books, newspaper columns, magazine articles, stories, plays and also books that were never published. There is also extensive biographical information regarding the tenor Chauncey Olcott, New York City Mayor James Walker, authors George Bernard Shaw and Frank Harris, actress Betty Compton and baseball player Satchel Paige.

The correspondence files provide insight into Frank Scully's political activism, writing career, and acquaintances. The majority of the files, other than those of publishers, contain only one or two letters.
