

boundaries, and at far less cost to any single nation.

I therefore appeal to you, Mr. Prime Minister, to take the necessary steps to place the UFO problem on the agenda of the UN General Assembly. I make this appeal directly to you because my brief to the Senate Committee, which was written with the objective of eventually obtaining UN action through Canada, was ignored by Senator Lamontagne on the grounds that his Committee was concerned only with broad science policy rather than specific projects.

Should you agree to take this action, I would be prepared to assist the Government by providing supporting data on the problem if so desired, as it happens that my own personal collection of literature on this matter exceeds that of the National Research Council and the National Science Library.

In the meantime, I take pleasure in presenting to you a copy of my book with my compliments, and I hope I will be favoured with an early reply to this appeal.
