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Space Capsule Part Discovered in Quebec

Authorities said yesterday that a partly oxidized 1000 # metal object, found 20 miles west of here, may have been part of a rocket used to put a satellite into orbit. The object was found some weeks ago on the shore of the St Lawrence River near the village of Les Escoumils by a fisherman. Residents of the village have since communicated with Paul Thadeau, director of the Quebec Observatory, seeking information. Mr Thadeau said the object probably is the remains of a space capsule but that it has no scientific value (London Free Press Sept 27, 1960)
