The CENTER FOR UFO STUDIES was founded in 1973 as a not-for-profit educational and scientific research organization for the study of the general class of phenomena known as the unidentified flying objects. The CENTER has become an international clearing-house for the exchange and investigation of UFO sighting reports and a major source of reliable information about UFOs for school libraries, local study groups and the general public.

Funding for all CENTER activities is derived solely from interested individuals and private organizations. All such contributions are tax-deductible.

ASSOCIATES of the CENTER receive various publications, including a monthly newsletter, a quarterly bulletin, a semi-annual journal and other special mailings, according to the level of associate participation.

The CENTER operates a toll-free telephone number available to law enforcement agencies and scientific organizations for the transmission of sighting reports. The public telephone number is (312) 491-6666 and it is available to pre-paid calls on a 24-hour basis.

All reports coming to the CENTER are carefully evaluated for investigation, such investigation often involving highly technical laboratory and field tests. If the report cannot then be explained in terms of a misperception of an ordinary object or phe-

nomenon, it is filed for statistical study into the CENTER's computer bank, which now contains over 100,000 entries.

For persons wishing information about the subject of UFOs, the CENTER maintains an extensive library at its offices in Evanston, Illinois, distributes its various publications, offers recommended publications of the CENTER and others through its Information Services office, distributes to broadcasting stations throughout the country pre-recorded public service messages, maintains a speakers bureau and is searching for additional ways to accomplish this purpose.

The CENTER FOR UFO STUDIES publishes its own reports of UFO sightings as well as a journal of UFO studies and other periodicals, makes available a number of the more responsible books on the subject of UFOs, and provides various reports and documents.

Most of the reports listed here are official or quasi-official analyses of the UFO phenomenon and/or of the social or governmental situation presented by it. They range in time from 1949 to 1979 and by country from the U.S.A. through Canada and France to the U.S.S.R.

Some of the books listed on the order blank relate to these documents, especially David Jacobs' excellent history of the UFO phenomenon and the U.S. government, THE UFO CONTROVERSY IN AMERICA. Part of UFO EXIST! deals with the same situation. In THE HYNNEK UFO REPORT, Dr. Hynnek describes the operation over the years of Project "Blue Book" as well as reports of individual sightings. Large excerpts of the reports within the Project "Blue Book" files have been incorporated into the paperback entitled PROJECT BLUE BOOK, edited by Brad Steigler.
