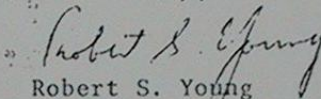


of the final report labeled Tab C, whereas the Index states Tab C is the list of documentary evidence presented. You can see, therefore, that the error on labeling the Tabs has existed for a long time and remains uncorrected, since to have done so at any time would have produced a different report than the original which was distributed in 1953 and which appears in the Bantam Book.

You will note that Tab C is of poorer quality than the other portions of the report and does not reproduce as well. The letter "C", in fact, reproduces as a blur. So that you would have no difficulty in identifying those two pages as Tab C, we have corrected that unclear letter.
