

A former military pilot and self-taught physicist has called on the United Nations to coordinate a worldwide investigation of Unidentified Flying Objects (UFOs) "because they do exist."

Arthur Reid Bray, who flew with both the Royal Canadian Air Force and Navy and retired recently as a Lt. Commander, has ~~challenged~~ ^{challenged} the validity of the famous Condon Report which caused the U.S. to drop its official investigation of UFOs.

Dr. Edward U. Condon, internationally recognized physicist at the University of Colorado, had been granted over a half-million dollars by the U.S. Air Force to study the UFO mystery.

His lengthy scientific report, presented to a special committee of the U.S. National Academy of Sciences in 1968, suggested that further UFO investigations by the American Government would be a waste of the taxpayers' money.

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
