Had a discussion with Mr. Bridge. (very disappointing) After 8 1/2 hours I now know not much more than before I went. Apparently Wilbur did not share any of his govt work or contacts with him. Seems strange. He was not aware Smith had helpers (such as Garland, Wilson, Whit, Thompson) during the Magnet period. I talked to him today regarding Dr. Schlatt's May 11, 1983 letter and the fact Dr. Frank T. Davies (a supervisor to Bridge) had worked with Wilbur. Bridge doubted this. I said "I've got it in writing." I am sending him the letters and he has promised to comment.

Once I have written a review of my recollection of the interview I will send it along. I did get a fairly good description of the anti-gravity experiments done 1957-196?

As to the Steeman material.

- as I assumed there were informal discussions where Bush's name came up. It seemed to impossible they would ignore the revelations in the Smith memo.

- again twice in the last couple days Gordon E. Coy name comes up, and his correspondence with Wilbur. Don't know if Steeman knows of correspondence with A. Wright in the US.
