

National Archives of Canada - visit 6 May 1976

Files do not go to the Archives until they become of historical interest, which is not normally until after 30 years, when they may be made public.

Dormant files may be retained by departments as long as they have use for them. Alternatively, if they have storage problems they may be placed in the Records Centre at Tunney Pasture.

The only access to files at the Records Centre is by departments concerned. Only they can draw the files from the Centre.

The Archives confirmed (verbally) that no UFO files are held by them, at least from the following departments:

DOT, NRC, DND, External Affairs.

In view of this, they state that the only access to UFO files would be directly through these departments.
