I have been going through our files and find that we never actually received a report from Dr. Johnson on the analysis he performed. He mentioned findings in a letter, of which I enclose a photostat.

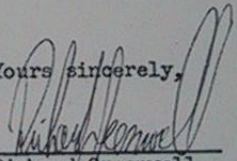
