SUBJECT: FLYING SAUCERS  
INFORMATION CONCERNING

*Following information was furnished to SAC [redacted] by [redacted]*

An investigator for the Air Force stated that three so-called flying saucers had been recovered in New Mexico. They were described as being circular in shape with pointed centers, approximately 50 feet in diameter. Each one was occupied by three bodies of human shape but only 3 feet tall, dressed in metallic suits of a very fine texture. Each body was bandaged in a manner similar to the blackout suits used by speed flyers and stunt pilots.

According to the informant, the saucers were found in New Mexico due to the fact that the Government has a very high-powered radar set-up in that area and it is believed the radar interfered with the controlling mechanism of the saucers.

No further evaluation was attempted by SAC [redacted] concerning the above.

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We come now to our last document. This is an official Report, also dating from 1950, written to his own Government, the Canadian Government, by Mr. Wilbert B.
