Further to my letters of January 8th and 25th, 1974,
enclosed is a further bulletin from the Center for UFO Studies
in Chicago.

This bulletin indicates the fast-growing support being

anxious to see a proper investigation underway.

What puzzles me most at this particular time is why the
Canadian Press is apparently ignoring this matter. The press

Ottawa Citizen thought this matter of sufficient importance to
tell people about it when I sent the same information to them.
