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April 12, 1982 - P.R. delivery to the media in New York City.

At 11:00 a.m. Associated Press called my office. At 2:00 p.m. from Washington DC. General Robert L. Schweitzer. My secretary informed both of them that I am in the city and will return about 3:30-4.00 p.m. in my office again.

4:00 p.m. From my office I phoned the Associated Press, and was contacted with that editor who possessed our Release, delivered on April 12 to the AP Central Office, 50 Rockefeller Plaza, New York, N.Y. 10020.

Conversation between the Associated Press editor and Maj.Ret. Colman S. VonKeviczky, LMSE, director of ICUFON.:

The editor informed me that General Robert Schweitzer declared on the Press Release enclosure # 1 (the NSC letter signed by him), - that "IT WAS A MISTAKE".

CVK.: "I believe you are mistaken Sir! Don't you realize the National Security Council's letterhead, which was signed ONLY by the general as its Chief Military Adviser, regarding the subject's military and security nature."

AP.: Do not you think so that it was a private letter of the general?

CVK.: "No Sir! No.1/I believe a general has his own stationary for private correspondence. No 2./ The letter was an official response of the National Security Council on our Memorandum addressed to President Ronald Reagan on Sept. 28, 1981, and on November 4th to him again, as the Chairman of the NSC. These Memorandums included 20 UFO related documents declassified by the Pentagon, which had proven the UFOs (Galactic Forces) potential threat to us regarding our hostile actions against them. The letter unmistakably states "WHAT YOU DOCUMENT SO CLEARLY..." It couldn't be explained otherwise.

AP.: Do you think so it was correct to publish the letter...?

CVK.: "The National Security Council three months of IGNORANCE on Mr. Jerome Eden's President of the PPCC letter, in which he honestly requested a personal conference - empowered us to communicate the facts with the public. It is also our citizen's duty to pay in the attention of the nations and USA our government's hazardous and wilfull negligence to act on the UFOs global and security problem, which is already due over THIRTY YEARS!!! YOU KNOW IT VERY WELL!

AP.: Your organization has only 100 members!?

CVK.: "You are mistaken AGAIN Sir! ICUFON over its 15 years of existence never accepted membership. Our leadership consist of keenly selected military scientists in UFO research, scientists, and heads of valuable UFO organizations all over the continents.
