Dear Carol:

You asked me to send you a note concerning the status of our famous metal, in so far as the federal government is concerned.

To the best of my knowledge, the Geological Survey has concluded its testing, although I have no idea what tests the sample was subjected to. Whether the tests which I specifically requested were carried out, only time will tell. I have been informed verbally by Dr. Millman that Dr. Smith of Geological Survey will publish the results of the analysis in one of the scientific journals issued by the Department of Energy, Mines and Resources. When this will be, is another question. Dr. Millman has promised to inform me when this has been done, and to see that I receive a copy of the journal concerned.

In the meantime, you sent one or more samples to other labs for analysis. I also passed on another sample which is being analyzed elsewhere, and I have initiated correspondence in the hopes of arranging for a further analysis in the USA. What I think we should now do is simply wait for the results of all analyses and then we can do a thorough comparison to note similarities and/or differences in the results. Only at that time will we have any real idea of how we stand. We may wait another year, but after ten years already, what is one more?

I do not want you to publish the fact that I am highly annoyed with Millman as this would damage very seriously my relationship with him and the free access which I have to see him upon request. Even though I do not get as much from him as I would like, nevertheless he has been very helpful in certain ways and half a loaf is better than none, as they say.

A chap named Jacques Roussin of Quebec City, and now a student at Ottawa University came to see me recently. He is a member of the S.R.P.M. in Quebec (publishers of AFFA). I got him interested in the UFO petition and he wrote to John Magor for more copies. (French version).
