

Striking new towers seen on moon

A story in the Montebello, California
News carried the report of a man who
believes that aliens are mining our moon
and planets of our solar system.

Kenith W. Templin, who has inter-
viewed at least 300 people about their
UFO sightings, believes he has uncov-
ered evidence that alien beings and
machines are mining the resources of
the moon.

"If our solar system is rich in minerals
that some other system lacks, UFOs
could be mining our moons and planets.
Then while here anyway, they could stop
off at earth for a closer look," says Tem-
plin, who bases his beliefs on NASA pho-
tographs and conversations with Jim
Irwin, a moon-walking astronaut and Dr.
ElBaz, an ex-NASA employee.

Templin said he talked to two men who
were hunting in the western part of the
United States who said they saw a saucer-
shaped craft on an ore pile of an aban-
doned mine. "Four tubular arms
extended out from it and moved around
in the loose mineral. The arms were
finally retracted and the craft took off
and fitted itself to the bottom of a cigar
shaped craft hovering high above," he
said.

Templin said NASA photographs
"clearly show 'X' marks in depressions
on the moon surface" which Templin
believes "represent possible mining sites
and the 'X' marks are crafts like the one
seen by the hunters only with the arms
more extended."

In the photos, which are without official
comment or identifying numbers, Tem-
plin points out that meteorite "craters
are nearly always perfectly round
regardless of angle of entry of the mete-
orite. Also the displaced material is accu-
mulated around the rim. The crater (in
the photo) has no apparent rim and is not
as perfectly round as one would expect."

Another picture, taken with a power-
ful telephoto lens, shows another moon
crater also lacking a rim. "Look at the
two Xs side by side as shown by the
arrow. Such marks are rather difficult to
explain geologically," says Templin.

Astronauts missed moon tower

"A few years ago," said Templin, "I had
the rare chance to talk to Jim Irwin,
Apollo 15 astronaut who walked on the
moon. No one was bothering us and I
asked 'What did you really see when you
were on the moon?'"

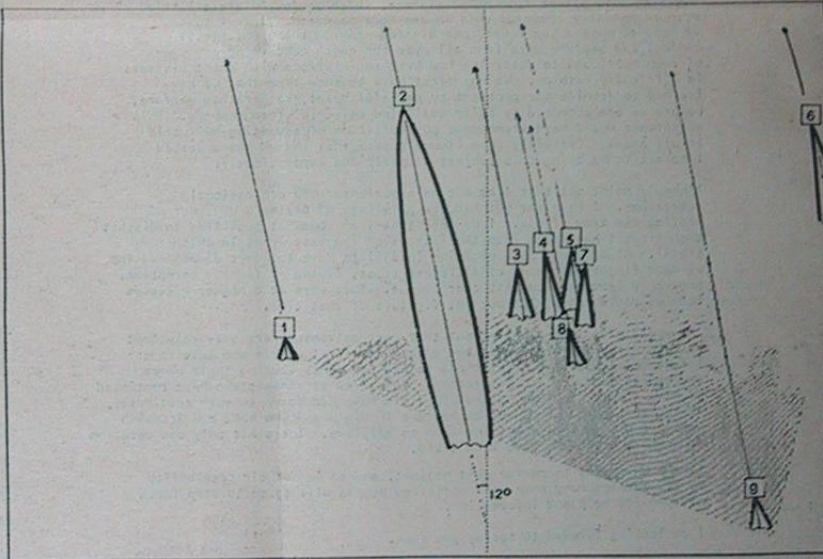
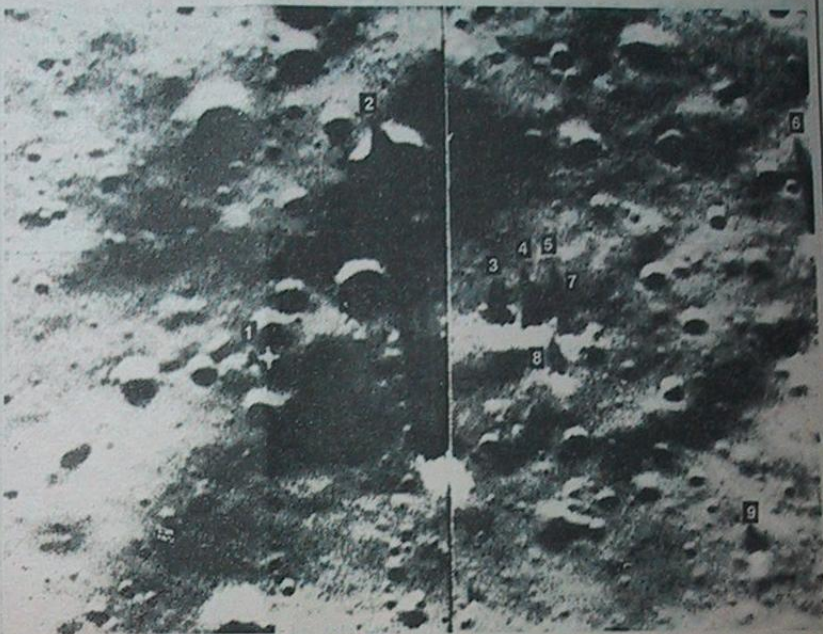
Templin said Irwin replied, "It is
interesting that you should ask, because
our landing site was selected to allow us
to inspect a 400 foot tall, thin pyramid,
constructed of a different color material
than the surroundings."

Templin says the Apollo crew had a
rough landing and had to glide quite a dis-
tance to find a smooth landing area,
which put them out of reach of the
strange object.

Templin also has a photo of the lunar
surface taken by Orbiter II which was
received by NASA on Nov. 21, 1966. (See
cover photo). He said the photo was given
to him by a Dr. Hibbs at the Jet Propul-
sion Laboratory in Pasadena, Calif., who
said the photos "defied explanation."

"When I asked him what he meant, he
said 'They showed shadows of things that
just can't be there,'" Templin said.

A conversation with a Dr. ElBaz, who
stayed quiet while on the NASA payroll
but began to talk after leaving the
agency, confirmed Templin's story, say-
ing that "some of the tall, thin pyramids
they photographed were three times
taller than the tallest building on earth—
and that they were constructed of a dif-
ferent material than the surroundings,"
said Templin.



This photograph was taken by Lunar Orbiter II on November 10, 1966, from 31 miles above the surface of the moon. The photo shows
nine pyramidal shapes of various heights in a cratered upland basin. The area shown is about 750 by 550 feet. The tallest protuberance,
according to NASA, is about 75 feet high. The structures show unnatural geometric regularity, as if they were constructed artificially.
Colman VonKeviczky of ICUFON, a military expert, says the structures are laid out like ICBM silos in the Midwest, showing a similar
distribution within a triangular area. The 12 degree angle of the structures is due to the oblique angle of the camera. (Graphic analysis

Other UFOologists have claimed that
extraterrestrials maintain bases on the
moon hidden under dark colored domes,
according to The UFO Encyclopedia.
Supposedly, amateur astronomers have
been observing the appearance and dis-
appearance of these domes on the moon's

surface since the 1920s.

One rumor has it that Apollo 11 astro-
nauts observed and filmed two UFOs that
landed near the lunar module. The film
has supposedly been put under wraps by
NASA. The agency denies any such

sighting ever occurred.
