

commission brings together leaders of the three main industrial capitalist regions, North America, Western Europe and Japan where they work together to improve relations between these regions. Usually the majority of the U.S. commissioners are members of the CFR. The ultimate goal of the Commission is said by some to be the creation of a global economic and political system, with coordination of domestic and foreign policy occurring among the Trilateral members. Accordingly, it is hoped by the Trilateralists that the Soviet Union, Eastern Europe and Third World countries will eventually be integrated with the Trilateral world to make up a cooperative one-world interdependent economy. Some see the Trilateral Commission involved in a malevolent conspiracy, while others view it as the vehicle for promoting a better world order by some of the world's leading intellectuals. Whether one views the Commission's goals as "good" or "bad" depends upon ones political and economic viewpoints.

For those who instinctively think a Bilderberger-CFR-Trilateral Commission-international banker conspiracy provides a basis for easily explaining the Cosmic Watergate, we caution them to read Jerome Clark's editorial entitled "Flying Saucer Fascism" in the *International UFO Reporter* of July/August 1989 and the book referenced therein entitled *Architects Of Fear* (20). It must also be understood when researching this subject that claims of this conspiracy make up a material part of the political ideology of the extreme right-wing, including the National Caucus of Labor Committees headed by Lyndon LaRouche (21) and the John Birch Society. For a consisely-written view of history that is conspiratorial in outlook, the book by Anthony C. Sutton entitled *America's Secret Establishment* (22) is suggested. The historical, political and propaganda morass that one must sift through to find the truth in these matters is beyond the training of most UFO researchers; we are truly out of our element. Tread carefully.

If the U.S. Government has incontrovertible proof that flying saucers exist, possibly as extraterrestrial vehicles, the impact of this knowledge at the moment of first awareness must have been enormous. If one knows what to look for, the signs of this event should be openly obvious in those political, military and economic decisions that followed. This impact must still be echoing down the decision making corridors to the present. Persuasive evidence is being gathered that points to July 1947, the month of the so-called Roswell crash, as that moment of first awareness.
