The California UFO Research Institute (CUFORI) has been formed for the purpose of engaging in and supporting scientific research into all aspects of Unidentified Flying Objects (flying saucers). CUFORI maintains a 24-hour answering service (213-378-0207), publishes the UFO Review, a newsletter devoted to informing its readers about scientific aspects of ufology, and seeks information about UFO sightings occurring in the southern California area. A major goal of the professional people involved in CUFORI is to make measurements, with scientific instruments, of UFO characteristics. This obviously requires that CUFORI be informed of a sighting while the UFO is still under observation. Since many sightings have lasted for an hour or longer and available instrumentation could provide a great variety of data of interest, this goal seems attainable if the UFO-observing public and the scientific investigators can make contact. Information about excellent past sightings no matter when they have occurred is also desired. The identity of those who report sightings, past or present, will remain confidential.
