Subject: Unidentified Flying Objects.

Dear sir,

My purpose in writing this letter is twofold; the first and primary reason is that of simple interest in your opinion of the situation as regards Unidentified Flying Objects or "Flying Saucers", in the light of your enquiries as the head of the Canadian Government UFO programme. I am lead to understand that your files sport the usual "hard-core" of inexplicable cases which presumably lead your group to suspect either some inadequacies in our scientific interpretation of atmospheric phenomena, a most peculiar pathological hallucinatory disease of global proportions, or the violation of Canadian air-space by extraordinary flying vehicles. I have heard of very few Canadian cases, and indeed, my acquaintance with any really worthwhile reports is limited to say the least!

I am currently heading the research sub-section of a local branch of an international UFO study organisation centred in England. I am now pressing for a proportion of our funds to be channeled into a wide scale statistical survey of "hard-core" unidentifieds on a geographical, topographical and chronological basis. At committee discussions, a number of as yet untried ideas have been put forward and provisionally accepted if material availability permits. It is for this reason that I ask whether it would be possible to obtain a copy of your files, or at least details of the unidentified sightings on record, which I understand are open to public inspection: it would obviously not be feasible for me to travel to Canada and inspect the files on site!

However, in any event, I would be very glad to hear from you with regard to any "estimate of the situation" which you may have to offer
