Many thanks for the letter. Much has happened since I last wrote. Have sent a few enclosures for your interest. I seem to be getting something major almost every second week.

- enclosed a letter from the CIA related to the NS-12 document indicating disinformation rather than a clear true or false. It seems to fit what I have seen.

- Friedman scheduled here in late January still lacks the document although he admits some of it might have been altered (I don't understand this myself as I got this second hand)

- Friedman has attacked Steinman's book, even tho' he admitted he hasn't read it.

- Steinman and Stevens have removed a second book. Apparently the first book produced a lot of new leads.

- not all the scientists involved in the Research & Development Board work are dead. The scientist who took the notes at the K49-50 meetings at Wright Patterson is still alive and there are probably more. The records of the Research & Development Board ~~was~~ (1948-1953) would be helpful. "Just Cause" stated a couple years back when they dealt with the Salsacher disclosure that they were going after them, but nothing has been written since. No one (including Salsacher) knew the names of the executives of the RDB.

- Solandt & Dr. C. M. Kenzie (head of National Research Council) in Canada attended RDB briefings but a good search

Dear Mr. Cote,

Thank-you so much for your letter of July 4, 84, and for the consideration that you gave my request.

Enclosed is a second request that is an extension of my first request of June 27, 84. In order to assist you I have enclosed a DOT memo dated Nov. 21, 1950., a memo dated Sept. 15, 1969 and a diagram of U.S. Naval "Project Magnet" which was connected to the DOT "Project Magnet" referred to in the Nov. 21 Smith memo.

From the memo it is apparent that Smith had communications with officials in many other departments such as D.R.B., and the Canadian Embassy. This is what is meant by discussion with other gov't departments.

These memos should help to show that there is much more involved than just sighting reports filed by "Project Magnet". There is no number on the DOT document. Hopefully it will mean something to you.

I am also still interested in some items not answered from my first request. Have there been any other Information requests since the Freedom Act related to the work of Wilbert Smith? Your letter of July 4, 1984 stated that DOC "has greater interest." Were all the Smith related material transferred? This memo might give you a starting point as to the aspect of Smith's work that I am interested in.

Again thanks for your time and consideration. I am sure that at times the requests might seem like trying to find a needle in a haystack. Wishing you the best.

re May 31, 87 article "Recovery of Allen's alleged" Martin Bailey states that a "bitter debate is likely to develop among UFO experts over the existence of a mysterious committee code-named Majestic-12."

One point to add to the existence of the committee from a declassified Canadian ^{gov't} Top Secret memo from W. Smith to G. P. Edwards dated Nov. 21, 1950, two years before the Eisenhower briefing paper.

"their (the flying saucers) operonoli is unknown but concentrated effort is being made by a small group headed by Doctor Vannernae Bush"

Canadian reporters have been aware of this document since its declassification almost 10 years ago, and although there has been pressure from Canadian UFOlogists the media has done no investigative reporting, settling instead for the gov't line.

On July 29, 1967 the Winnipeg Free Press wrote a story regarding a UFO landing base at Suffield Alberta. The "group of believers", mentioned in the article was Wilbur Smith the same one who wrote the enclosed memo.

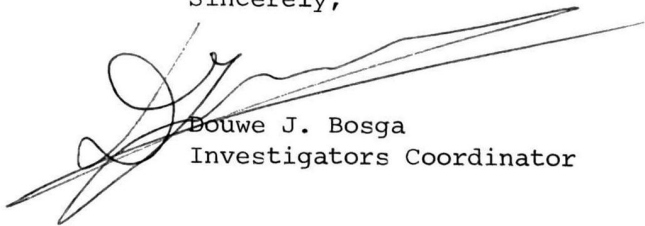
Recently I have contacted Mr. Barker about the missing documents of the Michalak case. I hope that we will be able to settle this matter to everybody's satisfaction.
