

A REPORT FORM

In order to acquaint the reader with the kind of information solicited on report forms, a copy of the form developed by the University of Colorado study group for its work is reproduced. It is considerably better than most other forms, and it is understood that considerable effort was expended in the psychological aspects of the form.

It is my opinion that little will be learned from study of sightings reported on such forms. They should serve as initial sources of information on which to decide whether field work is desirable. It is the field interview by the interested scientist that will determine the witnesses capability of observation and will permit the scientist to extract the maximum amount of information from the observer. It is regrettable that the scientists laboratory is so large, but only by such first hand study will we be able to get enough information to anticipate appearances.
