Dear General Goodpaster:

Your referral to the Secretary of Defense, relative to Mr. Richard Ogden's letter to The President under date of 25 March 1957, concerning unidentified flying objects, was referred to the Air Force for reply.

The Air Technical Intelligence Center has corresponded with Mr. Ogden on several occasions and furnished him with a summary of Project Bluebook Special Report No. 14 which outlines the Air Force position on the subject of unidentified flying objects. Considerable research would be required on the part of the Air Technical Intelligence Center to either confirm or refute Mr. Ogden's claims.

Heating
Senator Jackson's office indicated they did not intend to reply to Mr. Ogden. No useful purpose can be accomplished by responding to Mr. Ogden, and a reply would in all probability generate additional inquiries.

Dear Mr. President:

I am an aerial phenomena investigator, and I would appreciate very much your cooperation in my investigation.

For almost three years I have been particularly interested in a case concerning a Professor George Adamski of Mount Palomar, California. Adamski, author of two best sellers, claims that he has been taken for a ride in an interplanetary space ship; and he has taken photographs to substantiate his claims. I asked the famous Mars expert, Dr. Robert S. Richardson, for his opinion of Adamski's experiences. He told me that he felt that Adamski was suffering from a delusion; however, he pointed out that Adamski believes in everything he says and that he was not deliberately trying to fool people. I later pointed out to him that since he felt Adamski was not deliberately trying to deceive people, this seems to mean that it is his opinion that Adamski is a honest man. Then if he is honest, that means he did not fake the photographs which he presents as evidence to substantiate his claims. Hence, the question of how a man can take photographs of a delusion has not been explained. Dr. Richardson could not answer the question, for he told me that he could not answer all of Adamski's claims.

If this information strikes you as being interesting, then take a look at the following excerpts from Adamski's book, "Inside The Space Ships," and you will understand why I consider the case important enough to call to your attention:

..... I (Adamski) said, "About these people from other planets who are living amongst us . . . has that been going on for long?" It was Kalna (a Venusian woman) who answered, "Since time immemorial! Or at least," she corrected herself, "for the past two thousand years. After the crucifixion of Jesus, who was sent (from Venus) to be incarnated on your world to help your people, as had others before him, we decided to carry on our mission in a way less perilous to those concerned than actual birth on your planet. This was made possible by the great advance in our space traveling ships. We were able to bring volunteers in their physical bodies. These men are carefully trained for their mission and receive instructions in regard to their personal safety. Their identity is never revealed except, rarely, to one or another individual for a definite purpose, as with you. They mingle with their Earthly brothers to learn their languages and their ways. Then they return to their home planets where they pass on to us what knowledge they have gathered of your world. We have a history of Earth and the happenings thereon dating back seventy-eight million years. Similar histories which were made by men on Earth have been lost with the civili-

zations that destroyed themselves--the same pattern of destruction that threatens you today. The thing you call 'war' has not existed anywhere else in our system for millions of years. Of course, all planets and their people must pass through the orderly stages of evolvement from lower to higher. But yours has not been an orderly or natural progress; rather, an endless repetition of growth and destruction, growth and destruction...." (Pages 104-106)

One of the Martian ladies said, "You Earth people do not desire to show such cruelty towards one another. This, as you have been told before, is merely the result of your self-ignorance, which in turn blinds you to the laws of the Universe of which we are all a part. Within your families, you speak much of the love you feel for one another. Yet this very love you profess to hold often expresses itself as a possessive power of bondage over another. Nothing could be more contrary to love in its free state. Genuine love must embrace respect, mutual confidence and understanding. As known and expressed on other worlds, love contains nothing of the false possessiveness which perverts it upon the Earth. We understand love as a radiation from the heart of Deity through all creation, and especially through man towards all other forms, without division of any kind. In reality, it is not possible to find virtue in one form, and none in another. Yet, notice the distortion existing on Earth, solely because man there understands neither himself nor his Divine Father. Because of this ignorance, men go forth in what you call 'war' to slaughter ruthlessly those of another nation, another color, another religion, without understanding what they do. It is difficult for us of other worlds to grasp why men of Earth cannot see that not only is the mutual destruction of themselves by themselves no answer to any problem, but a cause for further woe on Earth. So it has always been and so it will always be. Now that your scientific knowledge has so far outstripped your social and human progress, the gap between must be filled with urgent haste. Men of your Earth know the terrible power sealed within the bombs they are piling up for use against one another. Yet they blunder on ever nearer to the brink of an unthinkable world-wide slaughter. This, to us, is strangely illogical." (Pages 136-138)

"Yes," one of the men agreed, "your behavior does often seem illogical to us. Let me give you an example. You have physical fathers on Earth, do you not?" "Yes," I (Adamski) replied. "If you had two sons, born of your own flesh and blood, as you say, and if for one reason or another one of your sons knelt before you and asked your blessing on his determination to slay his brother, who is also your son, would you grant his re-

quest because he professed himself right and his brother wrong?" My (Adamski) reply was naturally, "Of course not!" "Yet," he pointed out, "that is exactly what you Earthlings have been doing throughout the centuries. You all acknowledge a Supreme Being according to your understanding, and you speak of the brotherhood of mankind. Yet you ask the Eternal Father of all things to do that which you yourself would not do. For when you people are warring against one another, you fall to your knees in unholy prayer. You ask your Divine Father to bless your efforts to gain a victory over your own life-brother, even to the extent of destroying him. We, as your brothers living on other worlds than your own, view impartially the divided groups of people upon your planet. We, who have learned more regarding our Father's laws, operative throughout the Universe, cannot make the distinctions that keep you in such constant turmoil and we are saddened to see what is taking place on your Earth. We, as brothers of all mankind, are willing to help all those whom we can reach and who desire our help. But at no time may we force our way of life upon the people of your world. In reality, there are no inherently bad people on Earth, nor anywhere in the Universe. If, as many of you express it, your lives seem to consist of a 'hell on Earth,' you yourselves are to blame. Your planet, even as all others, was created by our One Divine Creator and is in itself a holy place, as are all His creations. Were all mankind suddenly to be swept from the face of Earth, and with them the strife and woe and grief they have brought upon it by not learning how to live together, Earth would be beautiful. But never so beautiful as a world on which men live as brothers with all in the Universe. Because one man is a stranger to another does not give him the right to ignore, insult, or to kill a fellow being. You have set aside a day each year for the observance of the Brotherhood of Man, and you speak of the Fatherhood of the Creator. Yet, in complete oblivion of the actions which such declarations should bring forth, you lavish money and effort toward swifter and more widespread ways of maiming and destroying your fellow men on Earth. Does it not seem curious to pray to the Divine Father to bless your efforts in this ruthless destruction? We hear these prayers coming from your temples, from your government leaders, from your homes and from the battlefields. Can you not see how far astray you have gone? For you are actually asking your Divine Father to do that which you yourself would not do for your own children. Can you not see how hypocritical you have become? And this is but one illustration of the many things which you do against your Divine Father. So long as you live this way, divided one against the other, your sorrows will be

multiplied. For when you seek your brother's life, someone seeks yours. This is the meaning of the words once spoken by Jesus of Nazareth. Remember that he said: 'Put up again thy sword into its place: for all they who take the sword shall perish with the sword.' The truth of these words has been proven throughout the history of man on Earth." (Pages 137-140)

Orthon (a Venusian male) replied, . . . "Our ships perform feats in your skies which no Earthly planes of any nation can do. Your scientists know this. Your governments know this. The pilots of your planes everywhere in your world have seen us and marveled. Thousands of your people have looked up and been amazed. Thousands more everywhere are now watching and hoping for a glimpse of us. All this has been foretold by men of old. They have said in your written prophecies that the whole world will be disturbed, and that the signs will be these: Sons of God will be coming from Heaven to Earth to deliver the peoples. The conditions in your world today have placed you, as you put it, under the shadow of death. Your entire world is disturbed. And since the name you have for outer space is 'Heaven,' and since we too are sons and daughters of God, could it not be that even now the ancient prophecy is being fulfilled? It has also been foretold that, when time cometh, the dark races of the world will rise up and demand the right to equal respect and the lot of free men so long denied them by you of lighter skins. Is not this prophecy, too, being fulfilled in these very days on Earth? You see, we know the history of your world well. The conception of 'We are our brother's keeper' applies to all mankind everywhere. It is in this role that we come to you and say, 'Let the Supreme Being of the Universe be the guiding word for your world that your troubles may vanish as darkness before light.' What would man be without the breath of life? And who giveth unto him? Is it not to be found everywhere for the benefit of all? Then let Earthly man know that his God is not in some far distant place, but ever near in all manifestations, and within Man himself." (Pages 240-242)

I have quoted this much material in hope of impressing you with the fact that the Adamski story is not a story to be casted aside without time being taken to give serious consideration to the validity of his story. However, I should like you to know that I am not a confirmed believer in the interplanetary answer to the so-called "flying saucer mystery" nor am I a confirmed non-believer. I believe in examining evidence both in favor and against Professor Adamski before drawing any conclusion, so far there has been insufficient evidence to warrant a conclusion.

I have found evidence against Professor Adamski's claims and I have found evidence in favor of his claims. The important piece of evidence in favor of Adamski comes from Air Technical Intelligence.

In the book, "Flying Saucers Have Landed," Adamski reports that on Thursday, 20 November 1952, that he saw a gigantic cigar-shaped silvery ship. On page 192 he said, "Silently, but quickly, it crossed above the crest of the mountains and was lost to my sight, but not before a number of our planes roared overhead in an apparent effort to circle this gigantic stranger." The location of this sighting took place at 10.2 miles from Desert Center, California. Mr. Desmond Leslie, co-author of "Flying Saucers Have Landed," wrote in Adamski's other best seller, "Inside The Space Ships," on page 24 the following: "All six witnesses to Adamski's contact--Dr. and Mrs. George Williamson, Mr. and Mrs. Al Bailey, Mrs. Lucy McGinnis and Mrs. Alice Wells--affirm that low-flying Air Force planes were circling and swooping during the whole episode; this has never been confirmed or denied by the Air Force." After the Air Force planes went away, all six witnesses saw Adamski make contact with a human being from the planet Venus. The Venusian had come from a small scout ship (flying saucer) which in turn had come from the gigantic cigar-shaped mother ship that had been sighted by Air Force planes.

I wrote a letter to Air Technical Intelligence Center and asked for the truth about this episode. I wanted to know if they had received a UFO report from this area on 20 November 1952. Wallace W. Elwood, 1st Lt., USAF Assistant Adjutant, said, "In response to your letter of 18 July 1956 we are inclosing a summary of Project Bluebook Special Report #14, which was released in October 1955. The full report statistically covers all reports up to that date, including a report by an Air Force pilot on 20 November 1952 from the general vicinity of Desert Center, California." I later wrote another letter to AFIC and asked the following questions concerning the sighting:

1. There was supposed to be several Air Force planes in the area at the time of the sighting. Did the other pilots also see the UFO--a cigar-shaped silvery object?
2. According to the six witnesses on the ground, the object was flying at a low altitude. At what altitude did the Air Force pilot think that the UFO was flying?
3. Did radar confirm the sighting?
4. You told me that Project Bluebook Special Report #14 statistically covers this UFO report. What is Air Technical Intelligence explanation of this UFO sighting or is it just listed as UNKNOWN in Report #14?

I received a letter from T. J. Connair, Jr., Major, USAF, Adjutant; and he said, "This is in reply to your letter dated 15 August 1956, in which you request specific information concerning the reported UFO sighting near Desert Center,

California, on 20 November 1952. It is Air Force policy not to release details of its UFO investigations. This policy is based partly on the volume of inquiries, partly on a desire to protect the privacy of our sources and the information they submit. Your letter indicates an intelligent interest in aerial phenomena and was especially appreciated for this reason."

My questions were of such a general nature that I fail to see that they would be an infringement on the privacy of any source of information, since I asked for no names or information of such a technical nature that would reveal a military secret. On the other hand, I can see why ATIC wouldn't want to take time to supply details of a UFO investigation to every person who made an inquiry, because it would take too much time to answer letters. I wouldn't have asked ATIC to supply details to a particular UFO investigation nor would I be taking your valuable time in order to get information on a particular UFO investigation if the information I wished to have was only for my own knowledge. The information I requested was not only for my own knowledge but for the American people. When I complete my investigation of Professor Adamski, I had planned to report my findings to the Press. I am of the firm opinion that the American people should know the truth about the Adamski story for the following reasons:

1. Adamski is not suffering from a delusion; his experiences are not a result of a dream. This is proven by the fact that he submits photographs, a piece of metal from the flying saucer, a plaster of Paris copy of the footprints of a Venusian, a copy of Venusian writing, and affidavits signed by the witnesses to his contact with a Venusian, in order to prove his claims. In view of this, Adamski is either telling the truth or he has deliberately tried to deceive the public in order to make money.
2. I have included in this letter excerpts from his book, "Inside The Space Ships," in order to show you how he has used religion to create an atmosphere of authenticity. If his story is a hoax, it certainly is not a harmless joke but a malicious attempt to deceive people for a pecuniary reward. If this be the case, is there not something the Government can do about it in order to protect the public?
3. On the other hand, if Professor Adamski has really met the sons and daughters of God and received divine guidance, I feel that the U.S. Government should give his claims official recognition so that the peoples of the world will know what to believe. I hope you agree that it wouldn't be wise or just to keep the truth from the people.

I hope you see merit in my investigation and will consider it worth your time to secure for me the answers to the following questions concerning an ATIC investigation of a UFO report from an Air Force pilot from the general vicinity of Desert Center, California, on 20 November 1952:

1. ACCORDING TO ADAMSKI'S BOOK THERE WAS SUPPOSED TO BE SEVERAL AIR FORCE PLANES IN THE AREA AT THE TIME OF THE SIGHTING. DID THE OTHER PILOTS ALSO SEE THE UFO-- A CIGAR-SHAPED SILVERY OBJECT?

2. ACCORDING TO THE SIX WITNESSES ON THE GROUND, THE OBJECT WAS FLYING AT A LOW ALTITUDE. AT WHAT ALTITUDE DID THE AIR FORCE PILOT THINK THAT THE UFO WAS FLYING?
3. DID RADAR CONFIRM THE SIGHTING?
4. SINCE PROJECT BLUEBOOK SPECIAL REPORT #14 STATISTICALLY COVERS THIS UFO REPORT, WHAT IS AIR TECHNICAL INTELLIGENCE OFFICIAL EXPLANATION OF THIS UFO SIGHTING OR IS IT JUST LISTED AS UNKNOWN IN REPORT #14?

I am sorry I had to take so much of your valuable time, Mr. President, to have you read this very long letter but I know of no other way of impressing you with the importance of Professor Adamski's claims. Your cooperation in my investigation will, indeed, be much appreciated.

The White House has referred to this Department your letter of December 19 in which you enclose a copy of your publication "Flying Saucers: An Analysis of the Air Force Project Blue Book Special Report No. 14".

We are very grateful to you for the opportunity of examining this publication, and thank you for your thoughtfulness in sending it to us.

I am familiar with your exchange of correspondence with the Moss Committee on Government Operations inquiry into public information problems, as referred to by Chairman Moss at one of his recent committee hearing sessions, and with some of your exchanges with the Air Force. You are most assiduous in your research, and in your interest in the subject, and your publication will, I am sure, be a helpful reference volume on the subject.

The Department of Defense record of its long study of the subject, as published by the Air Force as the executive agent for the inquiry of several years duration is up to date, and there has been no addition of substance thereto since publication of your volume.

What the President had in mind, in the 1954 press conference reference you cite, beyond the quotation given, is of course not known to us. I note that Mr. Morgan did not respond to you on that point, and we, of course, would not presume to offer comment on that reference.

"But what happened was that Eisenhower got sold out. Without him knowing it, he lost control of what was going on with the entire UFO situation. In his last address to the nation, I think he was telling us that the Military Industrial Complex would stick you in the back if you were not totally vigilant. And, I think that he felt like he had not been vigilant. I think he felt like he trusted too many people. And, Eisenhower was a trusting man. He was a good man. And I think that he realized that all of a sudden this matter is going into the control of corporations that could very well act to the detriment of this country.

"This frustration, from what I can remember, went on for months. He realized that he was losing control of the UFO subject. He realized that the phenomenon or whatever it was that we were faced with was not going to be in the best hands. As far as I can remember, that was the expression that was used, 'It is not going to be in the best hands.' That was a real concern. And so it has turned out to be...

"It had been discussed with me on numerous occasions what could happen to me militarily if I discussed this. I would say that the government has done as good a job enforcing secrecy through the installation of abject fear as they have done with anything within the memory of modern man. I really believe they have done a job.

"One older officer discussed with me what possibly could happen if there was a revelation. He was talking about being erased and I said, 'Man, what do you mean erased?' And, he said, 'Yes, you will be erased—disappear.' And I said, 'How do you know all this?' And he said, 'I know. Those threats have been made and carried out. Those

threats started way back in 1947. The Army Air Force was given absolute control over how to handle this. This being the biggest security situation that this country has ever dealt with and there have been some erasures...'

"I don't care what kind of a person you are. I don't care how strong or courageous you are. It would be a very fearful situation because from what Matt [this older officer] said, 'They will go after not only you. They will go after your family.' Those were his words. And, so I can only say that the reason that they have managed to keep it under wraps for so long is through fear. They are very selective about how they pull someone out to make an example of. And I know that has been done."

2- If your answer to question #1 is in the positive, do you believe the UFOs to be extraterrestrial vehicles?

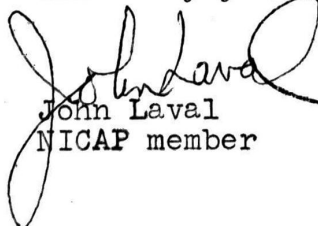
3- Do you believe the United States Air Force is conducting a policy of secrecy and censorship in regard to UFOs?
