Dear Mr. Pearson,

Previous correspondence with your Office has now made it clear that the Government's interest in unidentified flying objects is limited to any possible threat to the security of the nation. It has also been made clear that no UFO's have yet in fact posed a threat to the nation's security.

I am not seeking information concerning UFO's that may be a threat to us, as that is the job of the Department of National Defence. However, I am interested in those that were not a threat yet still remain unidentified.

What I and many other Canadian citizens would like to know, specifically, is the Government's view as to the possibility that UFO's in this latter category are intelligently-controlled space vehicles from another planet. This is a matter pertaining to the nature of the universe, the origin of Man, theology and other philosophical aspects and does not come within the purview of the Department of National Defence.

This, then, is a matter which should be of interest to the highest level of the Government because of its profound possibilities for all of Mankind. As one of many citizens who has studied all aspects of UFO's very closely for eighteen years, I am most interested in whether our Government has yet shown any interest in the possible other-planetary origin of the objects in this particular category, despite lack of "laboratory proof" for such origin.

A statement from you would therefore be most appreciated, pertaining to the point raised in my third paragraph.
