I refer to your November 21st letter to the Honourable Jean Marchand and the enclosed copy of a letter from Section 19 (1) concerning a UFO sighting station.

I am aware that there were reports, in 1953, of the construction of a UFO sighting station outside Ottawa. As my ministry was not formed until 1969, I have no records of such construction and, to the best of my knowledge, no such station was ever built.

A large number of books, on the subject of UFO's, have been published. One of the more recent, and possibly the most useful to Section 19 (1) is "The UFO Experience: A Scientific Enquiry", by J. Allen Hynek, which was published in 1972.

I hope this information will be useful to you in replying to the enquiry you have received.

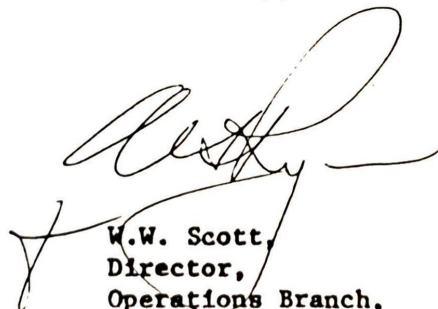
