NOTE: Bufiles contain nothing of a derogatory nature concerning [REDACTED] with whom there has been one previous contact on 4-12-49 at which time she was given a no jurisdiction-type reply. Bufiles indicate that George Hunt Williamson and George Adamski have come to the Bureau's attention in the past in connection with allegations that flying disks exist. In 1954, Williamson was connected with a program to be presented in Cincinnati which was entitled "The Real Flying Saucer Story." Adamski is the author of a book entitled "Flying Saucers Have Landed" which was published by Werner Lowery Company in England in 1953.

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
