

you consider our proposals or judge our efforts, allow us to give you some additional details.

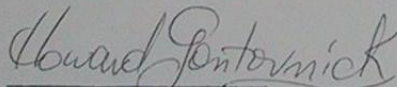
If we look closely at what Dr. Hynek has contributed and accomplished in UFO research, we find that he has successfully implemented and standardized a system of coding, classification and investigative guide-lines which can and should be applied on a global scale. Whereas many groups waste valuable time in dreaming up their own codes and procedures just to be different, we believe that by using the "HYNEK METHOD" if you like, on a global scale, we would improve the quality of research standards and efficiency. We would all be talking the same "language" so to speak. We have at our disposal not only a proven method, but also an international research language. Why not let it work for us and at the same time let it aid us?

Thus far we have been publishing a monthly bulletin quite similar to the International UFO Reporter for close to a year. Its editorial stand is basically this: ...more objective reporting...and a more rational approach. In our bulletin we illustrate a monthly Canadian UFO/IFO map detailing activity and differentiating between unidentified and identified objects. We do this by virtue of our participation in CUFOREN (Canadian UFO Reporting Network), our subscription to the Canadian Press Service and with the co-operation of our Canadian correspondents. We are also in the initial stages of establishing a Canadian version of UFOCAT with the help of one of our associates in Ottawa whose expertise is Computer Science and Programming. So we have now access to computers wherein we can catalog and store UFO reports. We are presently waiting for some information from CUFOSS related to this phase of our project. Furthermore, Mr. Sapienza is a Flight Operations Officer by profession and is in the process of setting up an official co-operative contact with Aviation Authorities of the M.O.T. and the N.R.C.

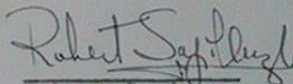
