When we have things organized, I will locate the copy and send it to you.

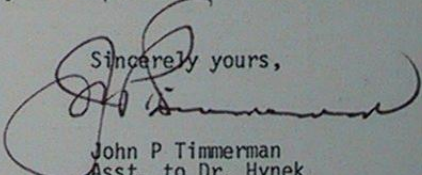
Your calculations are correct, if that were all that is involved in payment from a foreign bank. We have a new regulation relating to payment in foreign originating checks not drawn on U.S. banks with electronic encoding. There is an additional \$2.50 US dollars fee for foreign collection which has gone into effect. This forces us to change our forms and request that all payments be made by International Postal Money Order or similar documents authorized for domestic collection without international return. We regret this, but if we do not make this request we will lose US\$2.50 on every check we receive not properly drawn.

As you can imagine, it is a new nuisance for us and we regret having to bother you with it. However, we would be most grateful if you could return payment of your proper amount (\$19.50) in a Canadian Postal Money Order in U.S. dollars. We do not have to pay a fee on these items.

Thank you very much for your order and for your cooperation in this matter.
