REMARKS (Number and Classify each Paragraph)

1. In outstanding reports, this case is a classic which meets all the criteria necessary for a valid study of a UFO phenomenon:

a) The object was seen by multiple witnesses at different locations (i.e. Shenandoah, Pennsylvania and the dry lake bed) and viewpoints (both above and from the ground).

b) The credibility of many of the witnesses was high (an air force general, qualified aircrews, and experienced tower operators).

c) Visual sightings were confirmed by radar.

d) Similar electromagnetic effects (RF) were reported by three separate aircraft.

e) There were physiological effects on some crew members (i.e. loss of night vision due to the brightness of the object).

f) An inordinate amount of maneuver-ability was displayed by the UFO's.
