About a year ago, you wrote to tell us about "The Mysterious Chunk of Hardware at Ottawa", and offer samples of the metal for our analysis, or cooperation if one of us wished personally to examine the object. Your letter later came to my attention, and, in my response to you of September 29, I indicated a lack of interest in the mass because we could not establish a relation between it and any unidentified flying object.
