Dear Mr. Reid:

Although not a constituent of yours, I am very interested in a problem you raised in the House on December 4th and 12th, 1968, pertaining to unidentified flying objects.

I was, to say the least, disgusted by the reply you received on Dec. 12th. This was an obvious brush-off and is typical of the general attitude of officialdom in Canada towards this vital problem, which is causing much concern to the Canadian public.

I would like to refer you to a book I wrote dealing with the UFO problem, in which I gave many reasons for this casual attitude by scientific and governmental organizations, as well as the press, and I explained why it is that the public is not getting the facts of the matter.

I have enclosed a dust cover of my book to give you some idea of the book's contents. The book is available only from BRAY BOOK SERVICE, but there is a copy in the Parliamentary Library should you wish to refer to it there. It is possible that a perusal of this book may provide you with a basis for further questions in the House.

To prevent any misunderstanding, I have not written to you for the purpose of selling a book, but in the hopes of furthering the cause of the release of factual information to the public.
