Dear General Schweitzer:

Thank you again for your above-referenced telephone call and the opportunity given me to send you the information you requested and clarify some of the issues raised in your letter of November 21, 1981. (Encl. # 1.) In your November 21st letter, which was a response to the documented material and letter I sent to President Reagan to the White House, and on November 4th to the National Security Council (Encl. # 2.), all of which refers exclusively to the national and global threat posed by UFOs, you stated: "The President is well aware of the threat you document so clearly and is doing all in his power to restore the national defense margin of safety as quickly and prudently as possible." - My assumption therefore that you were responding to my 20 declassified UFO documents, attendant two Memorandums, and explanatory letter to the President - all of which dealt specifically with UFOs and nothing else - was both reasonable and logical.

You can understand my perplexity when in the course of our conversation you declared my well-founded assumption "a mistake", and advised that your response referred to the Soviet threat and that our Government does not consider UFOs as having "top priority". In view of the documented context I supplied, how could I believe you were alluding to anything other than UFOs? Furthermore, the sober construction I was forced to place upon your response is not without precedent. You may recall that in June 1978, Dr. Michael A.G. Mishaud, Chief of the International Security Department of the State Department, stated unequivocally, "Aliens from other solar systems are a potential threat to us and we are a potential threat to them." (This stark published disclosure was affirmed to me personally in Washington, DC, on August 29, 1978.)

Historically and factually, General Schweitzer, I am a serious and responsible UFO military scientist and an American citizen who does not minimize the dangers posed by the USSR. Nevertheless, as our Government's own documents clearly prove, the threat of a Global Pearl Harbor and what it would mean to all mankind exceeds in magnitude and consequence even the dangers of a terrestrial conflict.
