I acknowledge and thank you for your letter dated December 17, 1969.

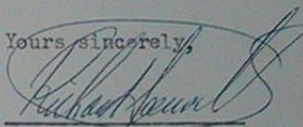
It is unfortunate I was not more specific in my previous letter, concerning the Scientific UFO Research Award. There will be no problem in your submitting a paper already written for another purpose, as long as it was written in 1969.

We would prefer a typed text to send to our Board of Judges, rather than the printed Canadian Government edition. However, if you have no extra typed copies available, the printed edition will be acceptable. We must have this, one or the other, by March 1, 1970 at the latest. I will enclose a list of the entries to date. Two psychologists or sociologists will probably be appointed to the Board of Judges headed by Dr. J. Allen Hynek.

When Science, Society and the UFO is published by the Queen's Printer, APRO would certainly appreciate a copy for its library and I personally would also like one for my private collection. I am desperately trying to collect all the UFO books published in English and Spanish during the last 20 years and although I am doing rather well the task is formidable indeed.

I will await your book Science, the Public and the UFO with interest and hope to hear from you before long regarding your paper for the Research Award.
