BRIEF FOR PRESENTATION TO THE SENATE -
SCIENCE, SOCIETY AND THE UFO BY LCDR A.R. BRAY

Reference A: D1350-23(DIS) of 29 January, 1969.

1. The following statement is submitted in accordance with reference A.
2. There are two statements, only, in the draft brief which contain information obtained from DND sources. These are as follows:
 - A. On page 1, paragraph 2 of the section titled "Past and Present Investigations and their Limitations", there is the statement:
"For example, it has been made clear to me by the Department of National Defence that that department has been considerably influenced by these reports", (referring to the reports of PROJECT BLUEBOOK).

This information was conveyed to me in letter S1350-1(DIS) of 20 October, 1967, paragraph 4, second sentence, which was in reply to my application for clearance to publish my book. The USAF policy statement referred to is an extract from the periodic BLUEBOOK reports issued to the public.
 - B. On page 4 of the same section, beginning on the last line, is the statement:
"My opinion about the interest of the Department of National Defence was confirmed when it was made clear to me recently that their prime interest was in whether any threat to national security was involved".

This was made clear in a 'fact sheet' issued to the public by DIS during 1967. The same 'fact sheet' made it clear that no threat to security has been found.
