The purpose of the item in the November issue was to rebut the Enquirer's habit of sensational reporting on UFOs. We have no doubt that Baron Buttlar and Dr. Smith's were quoted accurately. Our problem was that we could not see the relevance to the 1980s of a contention that was raised in the 1950s. Also, we believe that the passage of time shows that the U. S. Government did not hold information about UFOs more tightly than information about the H-bomb.
