Subject: Is "Tylla" one of Smith's "Girls Topsides"?

Hi Grant!

Hope all went well with you and your presentation at the Ozark UFO Conference.

Today I had some free time and I visited the UfoO library to check out the Smith/Bray UFO material in their archives/special collections. I photocopied some letters I had not seen before, including some interesting correspondence between Lucius Farish and Art Bray - and even a reply from Mrs. Murl Smith to Ashley Falk who sent her articles of what he already knew about the "Smith Coil". I think I have enough of a good description here to attempt to construct such a coil (along with the "Binding Meter" that measures reduced binding) when I get back to York U.

In reply to Lucius' January 15, 1980 letter, Art wrote "He [Grant Cameron] is NOT writing a book on Wilbert Smith.". After over 22 years of continued interest in Smith and his research, maybe you should reconsider and write such a book. Who else is capable or willing to tell this untold and fascinating story?

Did Lucius tell you about the Smith cassette tape he heard which mentioned many things about the "space people" and the information he received from them which resulted in various experiments that he has never seen published or written about anywhere? In addition to Affa, Ponnar and Alomar, we now have a Tylla too!

Although Murl was not willing to respond to Lucius' detailed questionnaire which he proposed back in 1980, in a letter to William Whamond dated November 17, 1976 she does reveal some very interesting things which I have long suspected, including how the president of the National Research Council gave certain physicists working on some UFO/New Science projects with Smith the choice of decreasing their work or ending their positions with NRC! In this same letter Murl also confirmed that Wilbert offered plans to

There are rumours
that this same P.M. ordered scientists and engineers with
the Defense Research
Board (which Dr. Solandt of UFO fame once headed) to disassemble

which would have made
Quebec the world's third(?) nuclear power! ;o)

I expect to be going back to UfoO to photocopy more of
the Smith UFO documents
and I plan to make copies to send to you and others. If
there are any others
files you wish me to examine and photocopy anything interesting,
please let me
know. I will return to Toronto after Easter (the Orthodox
Christian one which
can occur only after Passover) and my father's birthday
on May 7 so I have
plenty of time to check into many things here, including
the possibility that a
Mark 2 version of the AVRO Arrow may be still around in
crates. I just hope the
Deputy Minister for DND is a strong Canadian nationalist
like myself (not very
fashionable these days) and is not too concerned of offending
U.S. interests
(have you seen the huge newly completed U.S. embassy just
east of our
Parliament buildings?).

Chat with you again soon. I hope you share whatever new
things you have learned
about UFOs and tell us about your presentation at the Ozark
UFO Conference,
possibly on Errol's 'SDI' radio show too.

Dear George,

I am glad that the coil arrived OK, but I am sorry that I can tell you very little about it. All I know is how to build it and that it works. Apparently, the hole down the center of the core is necessary for its proper functioning, as is an adequate power input. It will take a kilowatt comfortably, without heating at all, and we know that it will work on 100 watts, but it won't work for us on 30 watts. It just gets hot on the lower power! I don't know what the lower cutoff power is, nor do I know what the upper limit is. All I can suggest is to do what the boys top-side told me; "Play with it and learn".

Please excuse me if I am slow in writing but as you say, the work piles up. I am quite busy at the office, and manage to get involved in a number of extra-curricular activities, and then I have to spend a bit of time with my family.

Don. Stedman built a simplified gravimeter which I have installed on a solid footing at home. It is quite interesting as there have been a couple of time field surges during the last month. Also when the Russians let off the Big Blast, there was a gravity wave which was so strong that it broke the delicate quartz spring in the instrument! If the Yanks set off some bigger ones I fear for the consequences. People just don't know about these things. In the words of Jesus, "Father forgive them, for they know not what they do."

I understand that plans are under way for a number of trips to pick up earth people for visits top-side during this coming few months. You might check with any of your contacts to see if they are involved.

Must close off now for the present, as I still have several more letters to write and the evening is advancing rapidly.

THE FOLLOWING MSG FOR THE PRESIDENT HAS BEEN RECEIVED FROM
ALLEN DULLES.

1. RADIOACTIVE DEBRIS HAS FURNISHED CONFIRMATION OF THE SOVIET
NUCLEAR EXPLOSION OF 6 NOVEMBER REPORTED IN MY RECENT MESSAGE.

EXISTENCE OF THERMONUCLEAR REACTION IS NOT PRESENTLY KNOWN. I HAVE
CONSULTED WITH VICE PRESIDENT NIXON, ADMIRAL STRAUSS AND OCB MEMBERS,
INCLUDING ROBERT MURPHY OF STATE, AT TODAY'S MEETING. ALL ARE IN
AGREEMENT THAT, IF YOU CONCUR, BRIEF PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT SHOULD BE
MADE PROBABLY FOR FRIDAY MORNING PAPERS SUBSTANTIALLY AS FOLLOWS:

"LEWIS L STRAUSS, CHAIRMAN OF THE ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION
ANNOUNCED THAT THE SOVIET UNION HAS IN RECENT DAYS CONDUCTED A FURTHER
NUCLEAR TEST IN THEIR 1955 SERIES."
