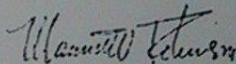
Dear Mr. Pinvidic,

This is with reference to your letter of 17 January requesting documentation regarding the subject of Unidentified Flying Objects.

With respect to documents submitted by Mr. Colman von Keviczki and Mr. Karl Veit, since these were not solicited, nor are they United Nations documents, they were not kept in our archives. With respect to verbatim record No. 8025 concerning a Cambodian proposal, it is not possible for us to locate this particular document unless you can give us information regarding the specific General Assembly session in which this statement was made.

The United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space has never had the item of Unidentified Flying Objects on its agenda and therefore this subject has never been discussed by the Committee or any of its subsidiary bodies. Further, none of the documents mentioned in your letter have ever been circulated to the Committee, nor, to the best of our knowledge, have these documents had any influence on any aspect of the work of the Committee or its subsidiary bodies.
