Thank you for your letter of Feb. 19th, it was a pleasure to know your requested material had arrived safely in Walt's hands for I had been speaking with him the evening prior to receiving the letter from you.

The confirmed speakers to date are; Yourself, Stanton Friedman, Dr. Hynek, Iris and George Owen (a joint presentation) David Haisell, William L. Moore and Michael Persinger, Professor from Laurentian University at Sudbury. There may be one or two submitted papers for possible inclusion to the Proceedings that are not presented during the Symposium.

The largest attended function, to my knowledge, was at the San Francisco Symposium which I attended. I estimated about 800 general public and participants. In Boston this past year the figure was approximately 400. We may be optimistic in this regard but 500 plus seems a reasonable figure for Toronto.

Yes, tables will be available for book sellers and other recognized UFO research groups such as MUFON, CUFOC and CUFORN, etc.

The Westbury rates for attendees are \$58. per room, per day, single occupancy or \$68. per room, per day, double occupancy. Do you wish a single or double?

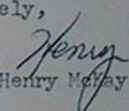
