Congratulations on your new assignment with President Nixon. As one of many, I am proud of you and your achievements and confident that whatever tasks you are given will be guided by your proven integrity and honorable sense of fairness to all. It is most comforting to know you will have a hand in molding the future of our nation.

I had the privilege as a guest of Dr. J. R. Maxfield, Jr. of Dallas, Texas, to attend the launching of Apollo 8 at Cape Kennedy last December. Never before has pride in my country and its achievements for the betterment of all mankind welled up within me as it did when Apollo 8 left the launch pad. My patriotism soared as high as our astronauts' journey. 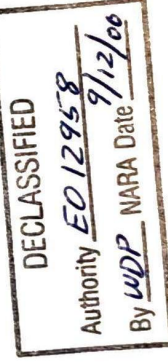

SATELLITES OF OUTER PLANETS
(TITAN)

With Mars and Venus now being explored in detail with flybys and orbiters, more and more earth-based astronomers are turning their telescopes toward the outer planets and their satellites. This is already beginning to bear fruit and some fascinating puzzles regarding the structure of the giant planets and of their moons are coming to light. Two good examples are Titan and Callisto, satellites of Saturn and Jupiter respectively. Although both are as large as the planet Mercury, about 5000 km in diameter, they are only half as dense, the implication being that they are almost certainly not made of the rocky material of earth and moon but rather a "slushy" mixture of ices and mud. This is believed to be the same mixture of primordial material from which the entire solar system was formed. The majority of the 29 satellites of the outer planets fall into this primordial category and are probably our best probes into the early history of the solar system, which is essential to understanding how the earth formed and evolved to its present state.

Titan, the fourth satellite of Saturn, is particularly fascinating because it now appears that its surface, apart from being made of muddy ice, very likely is covered with higher hydrocarbon compounds of the type which were the basic building blocks of life on our planet. This conclusion stems from some very recent earth-based observations of the satellite.

It has been known for some 30 years that Titan has a small atmosphere of methane, known on earth as marsh gas, formed of carbon and hydrogen in the proportions indicated by its chemical formula CH_4 . The total pressure corresponded to only 1/500th that of the earth's atmosphere at sea level. Now, new observations indicate that apart from CH_4 , Titan's atmosphere may contain substantial amounts of hydrogen and the total amount of atmosphere may be as much as one-tenth the earth's, or about 20 times more massive than that of Mars.

Even of more interest is the measurement of the surface and atmospheric temperature. It appears that the surface of Titan is warmer than what it should be if only direct sunlight were responsible for the heating. It appears that, with the

presence of H_2 and CH_4 , the atmosphere warms up near the surface as in the familiar greenhouse.

Based on our knowledge of the chemistry of the solar system, it seems almost certain that the atmosphere of Titan must, therefore, contain some ammonia as well. Both methane and ammonia are broken down by solar ultraviolet light which is available in quite an abundance, and recombine into hydrogen, nitrogen, and heavy hydrocarbons like gasoline and tar. Hydrogen escapes, nitrogen accumulates in the atmosphere and hydrocarbons should be deposited on the ground. Recent measurements of the reflectivity of Titan indicate presence of quite dark material at the surface. This observation is consistent with the suggestion that higher forms of hydrocarbons may be accumulating on the planet.

How far along has the chemistry of hydrocarbons evolved towards the formation of more complex molecules on Titan is, of course, quite uncertain. But what we are witnessing today on Titan did happen on earth several billion years ago during the early stages of the evolution of life. Titan, therefore, seems not only to have clues to the type of primordial material

which formed our solar system but also to the nature of chemistry which led to the origin and evolution of life on the planet earth.

Pandolfi: "Have you read the book, what was that called, it was a book published, ah, last year, [the] Howard Blum book, *Out There*."

Caller: "Ah, well, yeah, I'm familiar with Howard's book."

Pandolfi: "O.K. Yeah, and it talked about like a Working Group."

You know, I was a member of that Working Group, ah, when it started."

Caller: "Uh Huh. In DIA?"

Pandolfi: "Well, it was a ... Yeah, it started out that way, I was a member of it, but I, I resigned I guess after the first meeting."

Caller: "Who, who were the other members?"

Pandolfi: "Who were the other members? Well the meeting was organized by, ah, the first meeting was organized by, ah, Kit Green, and um, John Alexander. And um, it was about a dozen people there. But I don't, ah, you know I don't remember how it evolved. It evolved really quickly, but I left pretty quickly after the first meeting."

Caller: "But there was also a Navy guy in it."
